Required Documentation
Since complete applications are processed first, please be aware that the omission of any information will delay the processing of your application and may affect your admission to those programs with deadlines. NOTE: Your application along with the following must be received by NMHU before an admission decision can be made:
1) An official transcript (in a sealed envelope) from each university attended. Official electronic transcripts can be sent to graduate@nmhu.edu. Although NMHU requires official transcripts for final admission, please attach a student copy of your transcript(s) to your application to expedite the evaluation process. Previous NMHU students are required to submit unofficial NMHU transcripts, accessible through self-service banner.
2) Statement of Educational Goals and Objectives - minimum of 100 words, unless specified below in program specific required documents.
3) Letters of Recommendation – minimum of two (2).
4) Test scores, if required. (GRE is required for the Biology Degree Program)
5) A one-time non-refundable \$25 application fee (not required of returning students who have already paid the fee).
Program Specific Documentation Requirements (in addition to above required documentation)
Curriculum and Instruction: 1. Compose an essay of between 500 and 750 words which specifically describes why you selected this graduate program, and how completion of this graduate program will affect your future career and/or professional goals. (The 100 word Statement of Educational Goals and Objectives is not required for Curriculum and Instruction.) 2. Provide verification of Teaching Licensure
 Provide a resume A letter of application addressed to the program faculty Verification of teaching experience (copy of teaching license) At least one of the required letters of recommendation must be from an immediate supervisor and must be in reference to your application to the Educational Leadership program. Statement of Educational Goals and Objectives 750 word minimum, must: Express specific interest and aims within the program (leadership); Express aims for scholarly pursuit; Use professional language; and Use standard grammar, usage, and mechanics. Counseling and Guidance: 1. Provide a resume
2. Compose an essay of between 350-500 words which specifically describes what motivates you to become a counselor and what you hope to contribute to the counseling profession. (The 100 word Statement of Educational Goals and Objectives is not required.)
Business Administration: Official transcripts only (the School of Business may require additional documents at a later date). International Student requirement: Official transcripts, a minimum of two letters of recommendation, statement of educational Goals and objectives (100 word minimum) English: Provide a 10-15 page writing sample, preferably a scholarly paper written for an upper division English class.
 Media Arts and Cultural Technology: 1. Personal Objective Statement/essay (600-1,000 words) demonstrating writing capabilities, which addresses the following: purpose in seeking an MFA degree at NMHU Media Arts & Technology, research interests, personal and technical strengths what you bring to our program. Link to an online portfolio of best/relevant work, including detailed descriptions (2d work: 10-20 samples, video: not more than approximately 5 min. reel) which demonstrates proficiency, research or exploration in: photography, videography, digita imaging, writing, exhibition, design, code, games, or hardware projects. Three (3) letters of reference from individuals familiar with the student's abilities, work experience and personal characteristic 4. Resume/CV A phone or video interview may be requested before final acceptance.
Applied Sociology: Provide a writing sample. The writing sample is an important component of the graduate application. It should not exceed 10 pages. A social sciences paper written for a class or for publication is highly desired.
Psychology: 1. Provide a minimum 5 page writing sample, preferably a scholarly paper written for an upper division Psychology class. 2. Minimum 500 word statement of educational goals and objectives addressing research interests and experience (if General or Clinical thesis track) or to address career goals, interests and experiences (if Clinical non-thesis track).

3. Letters of Recommendation: At least one letter should be an academic reference (i.e., professor, advisor, etc.). The other reference can be an academic or professional reference. Letters of recommendation from family or friends are not appropriate.
