

Travel to NMHU Campus

Getting to the NMHU campus can be a challenge if you are not familiar with transportation services within the State of NM. Below is a guide to assist you to get to campus. Click on the hyperlinks to get to the websites of the transportation companies.

By Ground once your fly into ABQ Airport or other U.S. Airports

AMTAK = Tickets can be purchased from various locations within the United States. Make sure that your final destination is Las Vegas, NM (Station code LSV and not to Las Vegas, Nevada)

The most popular routes to Las Vegas, NM are from:

Los Angeles, CA (LAX) to Las Vegas, NM (Station code LSV). This trip takes 24 hours

Chicago, IL (CHI) to Las Vegas, NM (LSV). This trip takes 24 hours

Albuquerque, NM (ABQ) to Las Vegas, NM (LSV). This trip takes Approximately 3 hours. The Amtrak train station is located at the Albuquerque Alvarado Center, 100 First St. S.W., Albuquerque, NM 87102

At the airport you can go to Ground Transportation to get assistance on how to get to the ABQ Alvarado Center.

NM Rail Runner Express to NM Park and Ride to NMHU

(Highly advisable that this option is taken Monday through Friday only)

- Take a taxi or [Uber](#) or [lyft](#) (Lyft requires that you have a U.S. tele #) from ABQ Airport to the Albuquerque Alvarado transportation Center, located at 100 First St. S.W., Albuquerque, NM 87102
- Next, Your route will be from the Albuquerque Alvarado Transportation Center to Santa Fe Park and Ride South Capital Station to take the [Park and Ride Bus](#) (Orange Route) to NM Highlands University.

Groome Transportation to NM Park and Ride

(Highly advisable that this option is taken Monday through Friday only)

This option is a private transportation company that will transport you from the ABQ Airport to the New Mexico Park and Ride. Once you arrive to the New Mexico Park and Ride station 599 RailRunner Station

Pickup is in RailRunner parking lot at bus stop benches.
