- Maintain equipment at levels sufficient for efficient and safe fish production.
- Maintain raceways and fish feedings in order to produce healthy fish.
- Make all efforts to ensure the production of disease free fish.
- Maintain the proper function of the UV and filtration system.
- Maintain facilities for optimum fish production and to present a professional appearance to the public (i.e. mowing and trimming grounds, painting, trimming trees, etc.)
- Maintain equipment, including vehicles, for optimum fish production (vehicle maintenance and repair).
- Follow all department and divisional policies and procedures.
- Maintain a positive moral as measured by employee complaints.
