2012 SPRING VSC MCRP INTERNSHIP PROGRAM ANNOUNCEMENT

Vista Sciences Corporation, a New Mexico business, has signed a new contract to provide interns to the Army Sustainment Command and the Army Joint Munitions Command. The intern appointments are for a period of 15 consecutive weeks (JANUARY through APRIL 2012) and provide an opportunity for junior and senior undergraduates and enrolled graduate students in these and other fields:

Engineering: civil, electrical, computer, environmental, mechanical (Pro-E)

Sciences: natural resources, environmental, safety, industrial hygiene

Business: finance, accounting, marketing, management, legal, human resources

Computer Sci & Computer Engin: information systems, data management, programming, information technology, website/webpage design & management, MS Office Suite (including Access, PowerPoint), languages, trouble shooting

Other Fields: industrial technology, history, math, statistics, library sciences, journalism, risk management, communications, public administration, public relations, quality control, training development and management, and logistics

Students must have the following qualifications for consideration:

- (1) US citizenship (No exceptions)
- (2) GPA 3.0/4.0 or above, as required by position
- (3) juniors, seniors, enrolled graduates, and recent graduates (within 6 months)
- (4) pass rigid background check
- (5) enrolled in or just graduated from a US Department of Education Accredited Minority Serving Institution, Hispanic Serving Institution, Historically Black College/University, or Tribal College/University
- (6) leave in January, remain at worksite for 15 weeks, and return in April 2012

The internship appointments carry a \$500/wk stipend, with lodging and to-and-from worksite transportation paid during the 15-week appointment. The Army will assign a specific project to each intern and provide the supplies, tools, and equipment necessary to complete the project. The Army personnel will oversee the performance of the project and provide direct management and supervisory assistance to ensure its successful completion.

Work assignments for the 2012 Spring Interns may be at these or other locations: Rock Island Arsenal; Crane Army Ammunition Activity Center; Fort Bragg, Fort Hood, Tooele Army Depots; Anniston Defense Munitions Center; and Blue Grass Ammunition Depot; as well as the Iowa, Milan, Lake City, and McAlester Army Ammunitions Plants.
