

The Forest Service Job Fair at the Society of American Foresters Conference in Albuquerque on October 27-29, 2010

The Forest Service (FS) will be interviewing applicants for on-the-spot hiring at the Society of American Foresters (SAF) convention in Albuquerque, New Mexico starting on October 27, 2010. On-the-spot hiring offers a streamlined approach for the Forest Service to hire top talent from universities and elsewhere by utilizing noncompetitive hiring authorities such as Career Intern Program (CIP) and Student Career Experience Program (SCEP). For the CIP program, the candidate will participate in a 2 year intern program with the FS, will need a college degree or expectation candidate will graduate within 6 months, and/or have diverse professional experience and training. For the SCEP Program, the candidate will complete a minimum of 640 hours of work experience with the FS prior to completing his/her degree, and must be enrolled in or accepted into a college degree program related to the assigned work.
