#### Detailed Description

##### **Program Description**

The post baccalaureate category of the UGS program offers college graduates the opportunity to participate in the UGS program after graduation. This category applies to those students who have been awarded a bachelor's degree within the past 3 years, but have not yet been accepted and enrolled in a graduate program. Post baccalaureate students may remain in this category for up to one year.

##### **Education**

Completion of a Bachelor's degree by time of hire with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0.

##### **Notes**

The intent of this program is for the student to prepare for graduate school acceptance by taking the necessary entrance exams and applying to graduate programs while gaining some research/work experience.
