MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Bachelor's Degree from an accredited college or university in Vocational Rehabilitation, Sociology, Psychology, Guidance and Counseling, Social Work and/or Special Education with no experience required.

Employment Requirements:

Must possess and maintain a valid New Mexico Driver's License. Pre-employment

background investigation is required and is conditional pending results.

Statutory Requirements:

Must hold or be eligible for state licensure requirements in Rehabilitation Counseling as defined in the Public Education Department Rules (6.63.11). If hired with a Bachelor's Degree, it is required that the individual enroll and complete a Master's Degree program in Vocational Rehabilitation.

SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION:

Working Conditions:

Sedentary, indoor work with extensive use of computer and telephone. Travel to satellite offices and state office several times per month with overnight stay.

Conditions of Employment:
