Purpose of Position:

This position will oversee the State of New Mexico Deferred Compensation Plan. The Plan is an optional, self-directed, tax deferred, defined contribution supplementary retirement program offered to state and local government employees in New Mexico under Section 457(b) of the Internal Revenue Code (IRC) and the Deferred Compensation Act of the New Mexico Statutes. The position coordinates the administration of the Plan with a third party administrator, an independent investment consultant and various investment product providers. The position provides information needed by the PERA Board, which has fiduciary and statutory oversight, to make prudent Plan decisions. The Plan has approximately 18,000 participants and over \$480 million in assets. There are over 100 employers across New Mexico who participate in the Plan. The position must interface with Plan participants and Plan employers with respect to any administrative inquiry.

Working Conditions:
