



JUDICIAL ADMINISTRATION FELLOWSHIP

The Judicial Administration Fellowship Program is administered by the Center for California Studies at **California State University, Sacramento (Sacramento State)** and co-sponsored by the **Judicial Council of California**. All persons with a four-year college degree, including recent graduates and mid-career applicants are eligible to apply. Successful applicants demonstrate a commitment to public service and an interest in the administration of justice in the California court system. Ten fellows are accepted into the ten-month program, which begins in September of each year.
