**SUMMARY:** The Instructional Design Specialist (IDS) will be responsible for planning, designing, developing, documenting, and reviewing online courses, interactive web applications and technologies for the online Master Degree programs in Education for the Title V CONECTADO project. The IDS will collaborate with project teams, subject matter experts, librarians, professors, Educational Outreach Services (EOS), and the Center for Teaching Excellence (CTE).

## **DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Adapt and design online courses, which include instructional strategies for educational technology and creative pedagogy.
- Demonstrates and utilizes effective needs analysis, course development and evaluation skills.
- Will work collaboratively with faculty/subject experts to assist them in the development of various online multimedia elements.
- Will schedule regular weekly training sessions utilizing the Title V training Lab, located on the main NMHU campus, using the NMHU approved and supported technologies and applications for teaching online.
- Supports the daily operations through instructional technologies such as learning management systems, web conferencing software and multimedia development.
- Document all faculty assistance, write instructional development plans and status updates.
- Remain up-to-date on developments in the online learning and related technology fields.
- Collaborate with the Educational Outreach Services' Online team, and the Center for Teaching Excellence (CTE).
- Assist the CONECTADO Activity Director with meeting goals and objectives of the program.
- Assists in the development and implementation of online learning and other related initiatives.
- Provide on-going mentoring sessions for faculty as needed.
- Maintain regular attendance;
- Perform other job related duties as assigned.

- EDUCATION: Bachelor's Degree in Instructional Design, Education or any field.
- **EXPERIENCE:** Two (2) years of Higher Education teaching experience and Two (2) years of experience working with distance learning technology.
