## <u>Eligibility</u>

An applicant for a SLSTP program must:

- be a US citizen\*
- be in high academic standing (GPA of 3.2 or greater)
- have a minimum age of 18
- be a freshman, sophomore, junior, or senior undergraduate student next Fall.
- have a passion for space and a desire to study space life science.

Veterans, women, and persons with disabilities are encouraged to apply.

\*Citizens of US territories Puerto Rico, Guam, the U.S. Virgin Islands, and Northern Marianas are considered U.S. citizens.

Permanent Resident foreign nationals, Legal Resident Aliens, Work Permit holders, and Illegal Immigrants are not eligible.
