Are you between the ages of 15 and 18, and currently enrolled in high school? Would you like to spend your summer working outdoors performing historic adobe maintenance, cleaning trails, and providing fence maintenance? Would you like a fun job where your efforts make a difference for the history of your community? If you answered **YES** to these questions, the Youth Conservation Corps may be right for you.

To be eligible for the Fort Union National Monument YCC Program, applicants must:

- ✓ Be between the ages of 15 (by June 11, 2018) and 19 (not age 19 before August 02, 2018)
- ✓ Be a permanent resident of the United States, its territories or possessions
- ✓ Be available to work 40 hours per week (7:30 a.m. - 4 p.m.), Monday - Friday for the full time.
- ✓ Be able to get to and from Fort Union National Monument, Watrous, NM, I-25, Exit 366. (Approximately a 30 minute drive from Las Vegas)
- ✓ Possess a Social Security card prior to the first working day of the YCC program
- ✓ Have the written permission of a parent or legal guardian to work
- ✓ Have a bank account in your name by the first working day of the program
