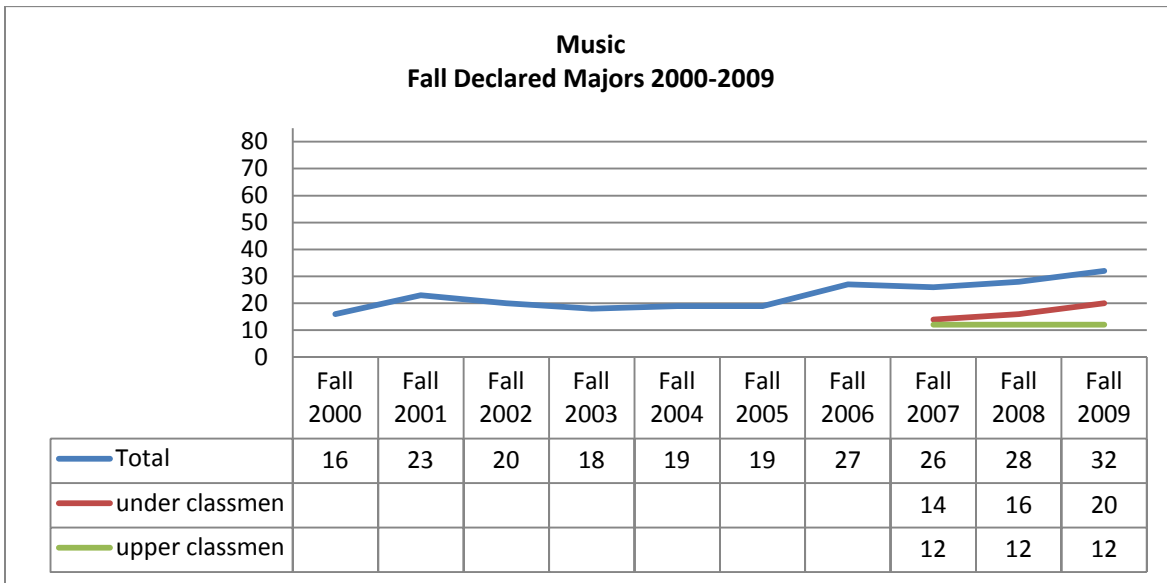
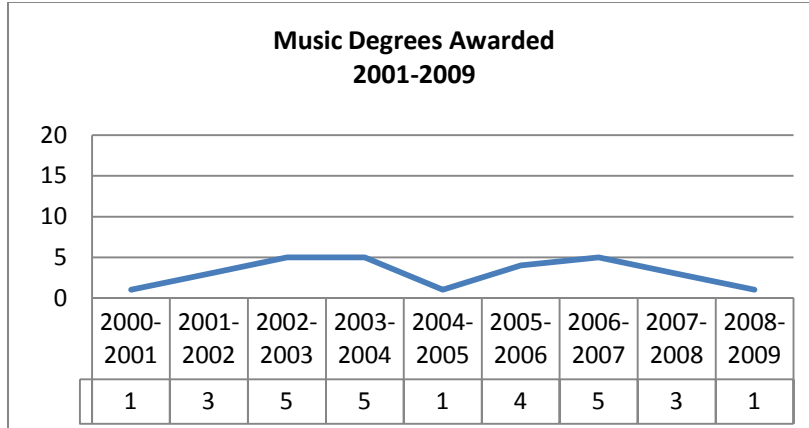


Media Arts Undergraduate Program

These charts include the discontinued majors of Design Studies, Communication Arts, Mass Communication and Visual Communication Design majors all of which were subsumed into the Media Arts major.



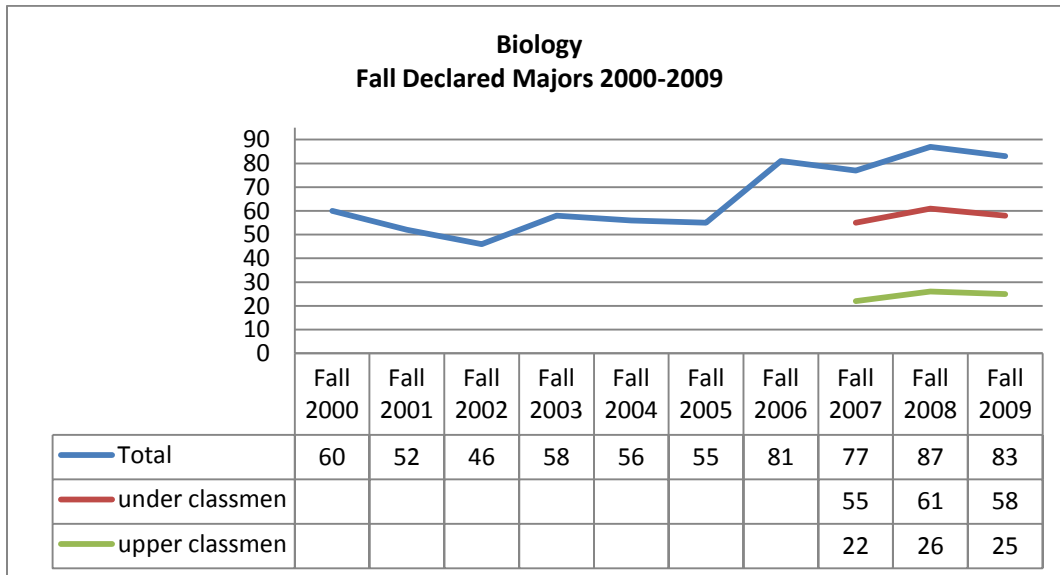
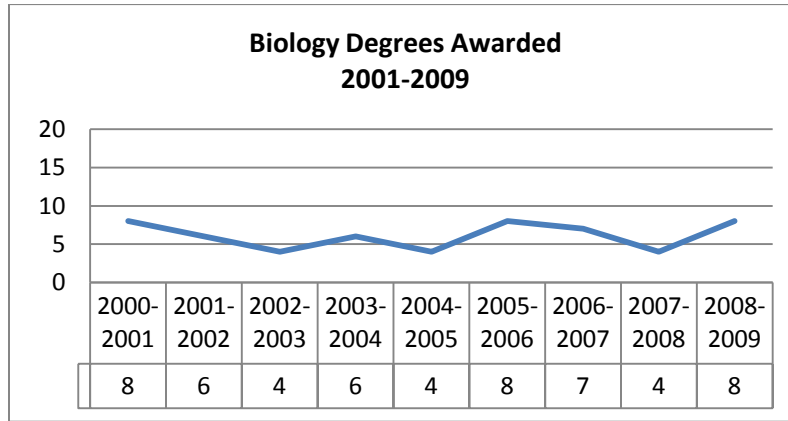

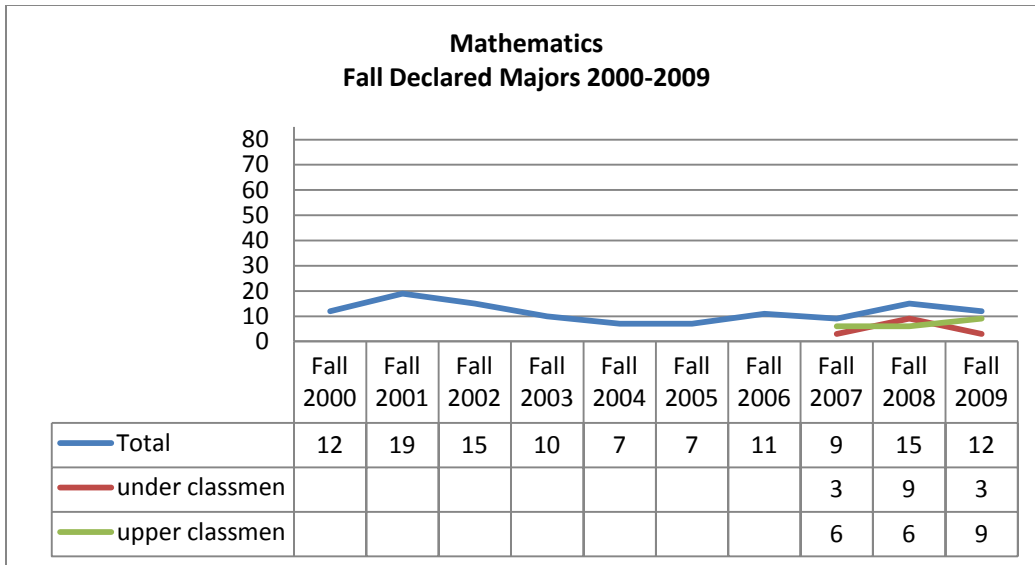


Computer and Mathematical Modeling Program

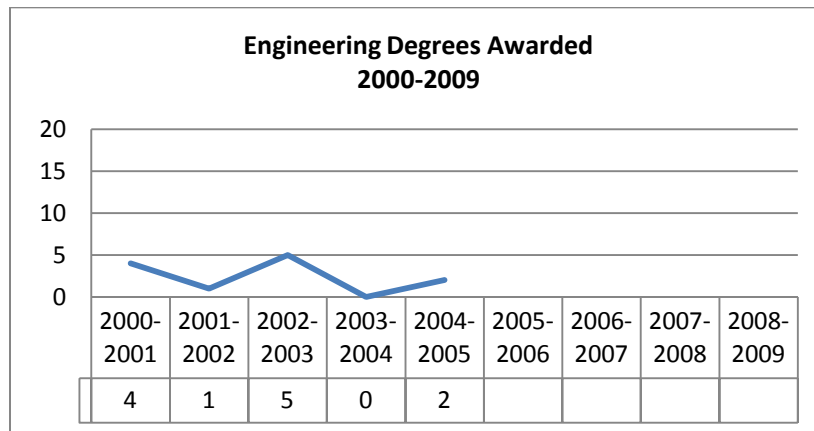

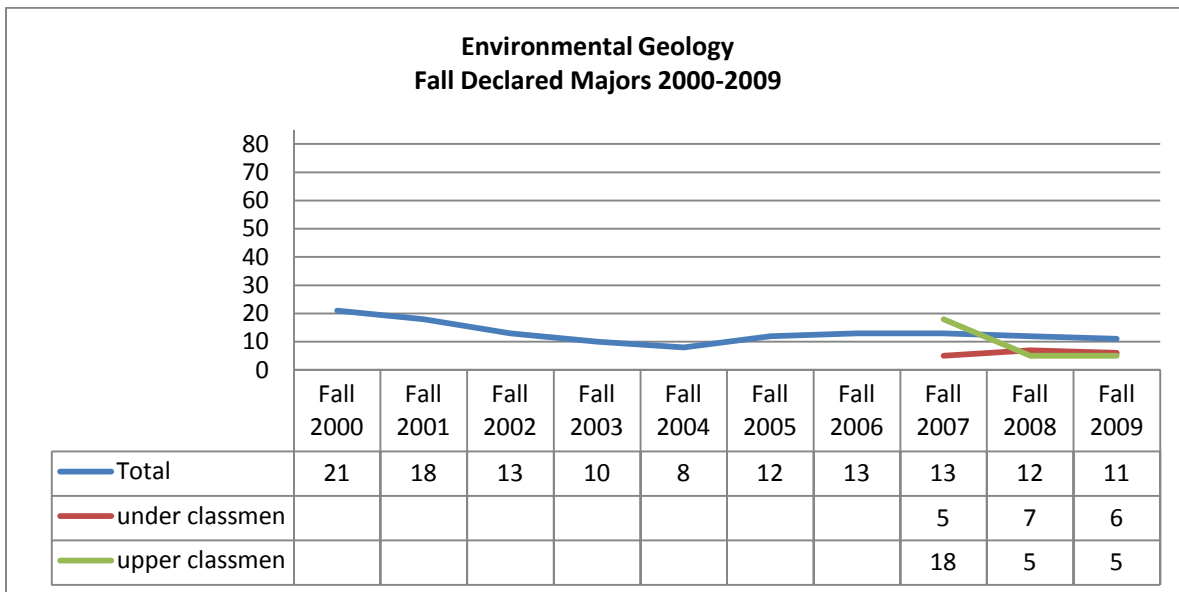
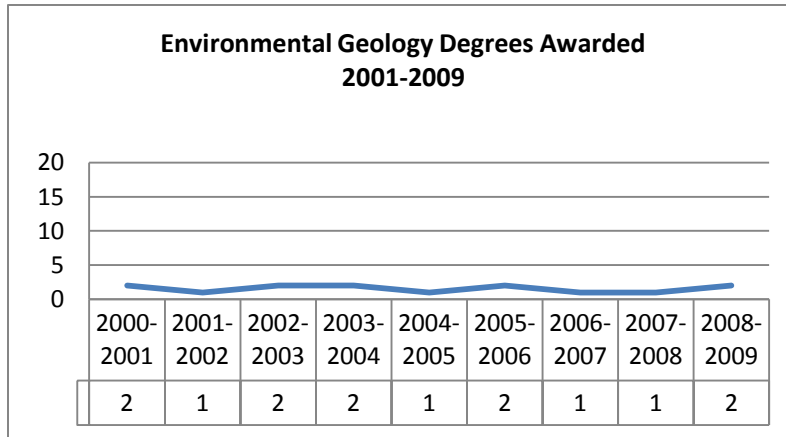
Forestry Undergraduate Program

These graphs include the majors from the Natural Resource Management program and Environmental Science majors with a concentration in environmental science. Both of those programs were subsumed into the current Forestry program.

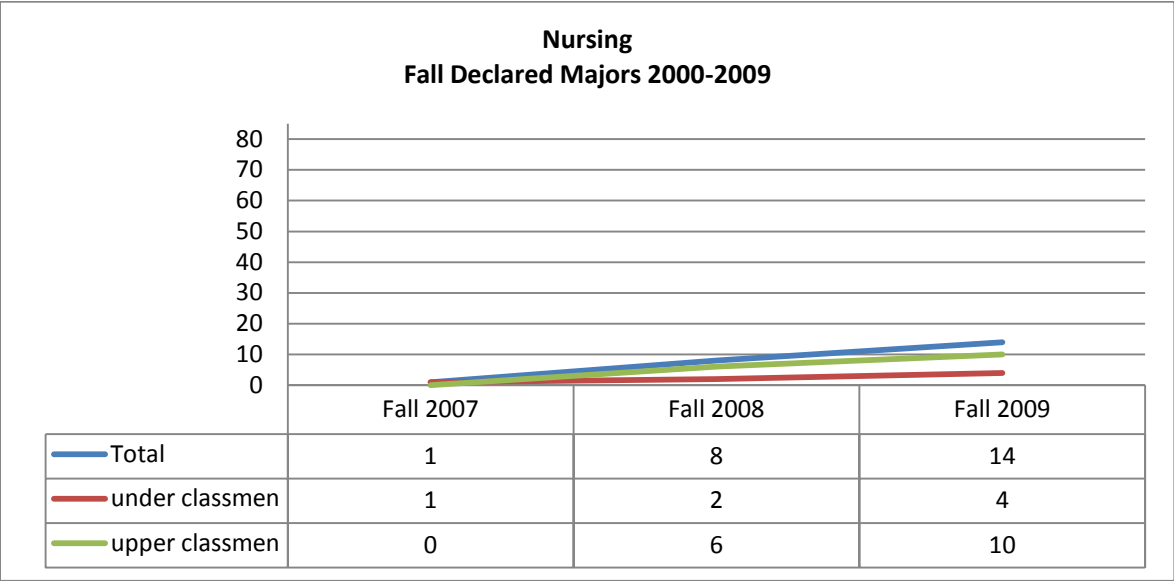


Environmental Geology Undergraduate Program

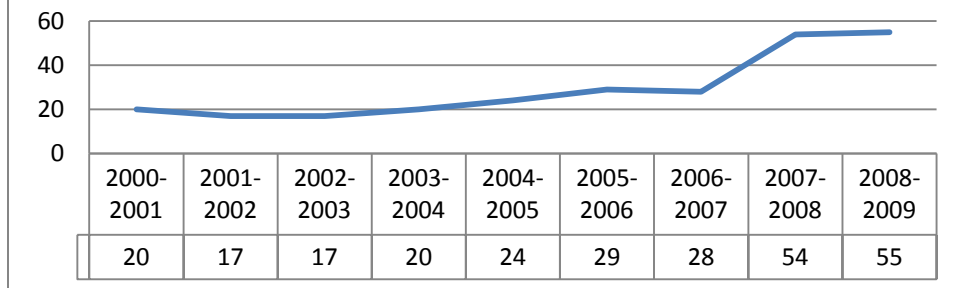


Fall Declared Business Student Enrollments 2000-2009

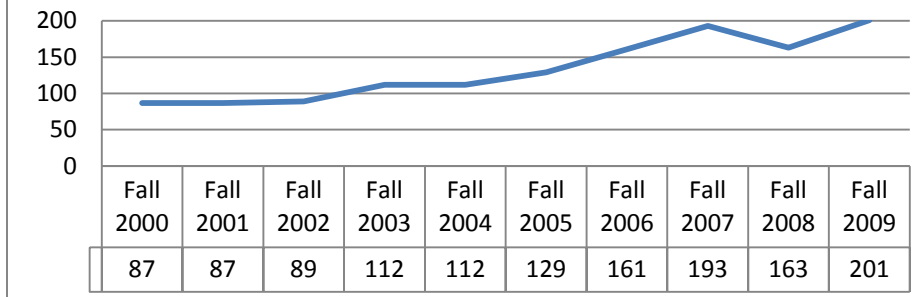

Master of Business Administration Degrees Awarded 2001-2008

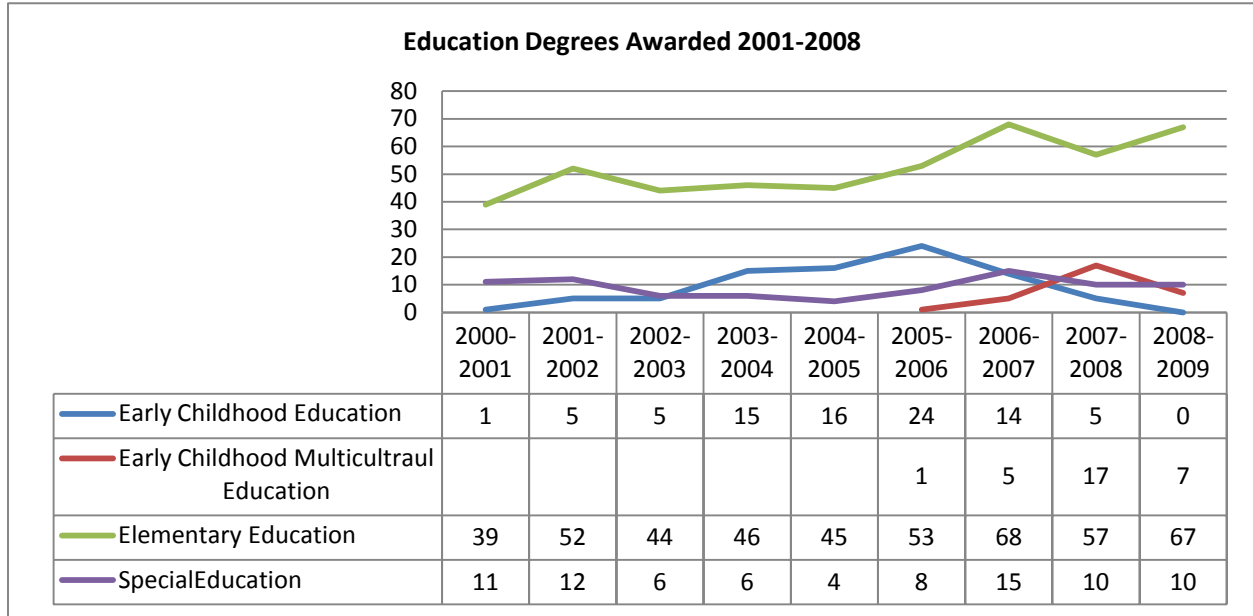


Master of Business Administration Fall Enrolled Students 2000-2009

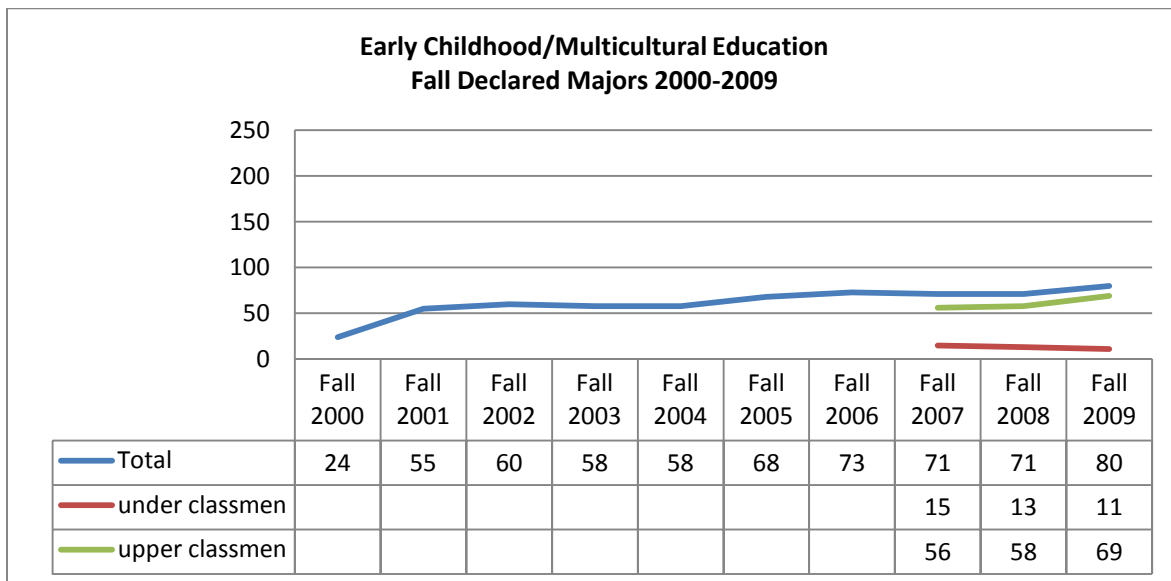
