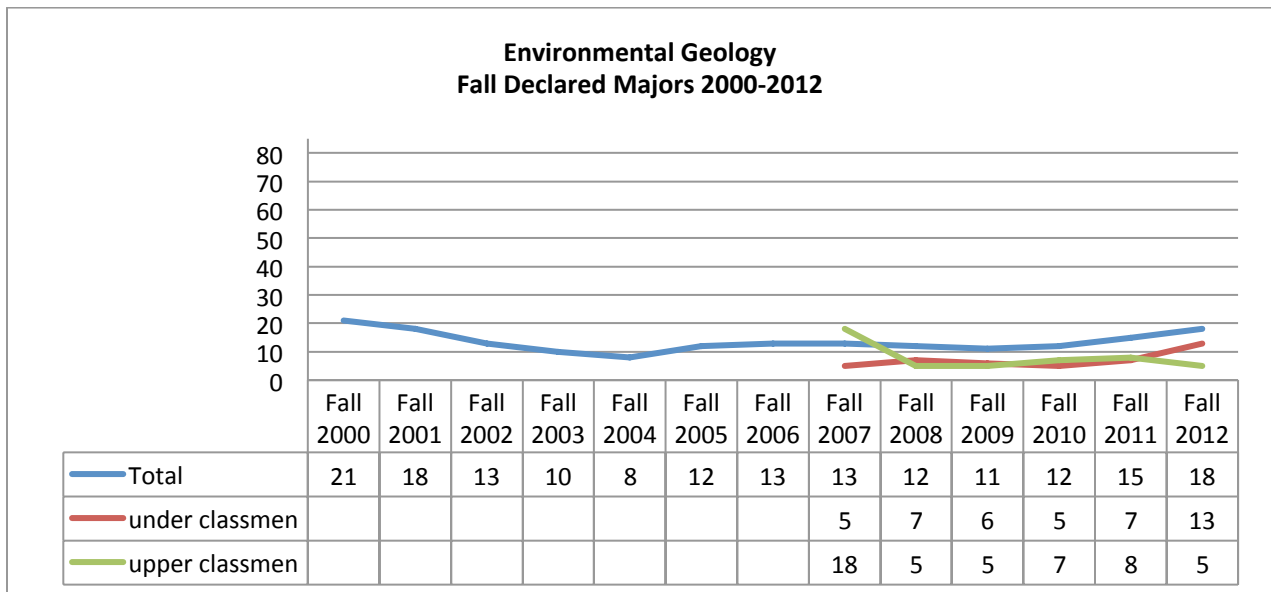
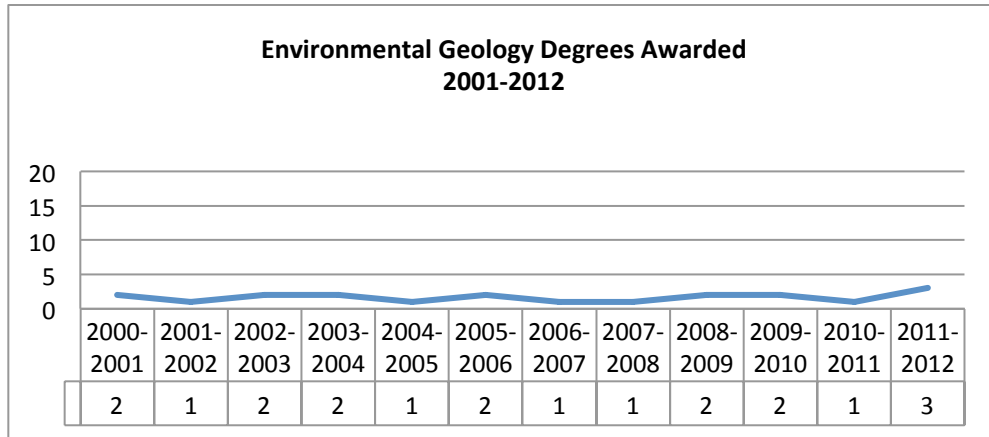
Forestry Undergraduate Program

These graphs include the majors from the Natural Resource Management program and Environmental Science majors with a concentration in environmental science. Both of those programs were subsumed into the current Forestry program.

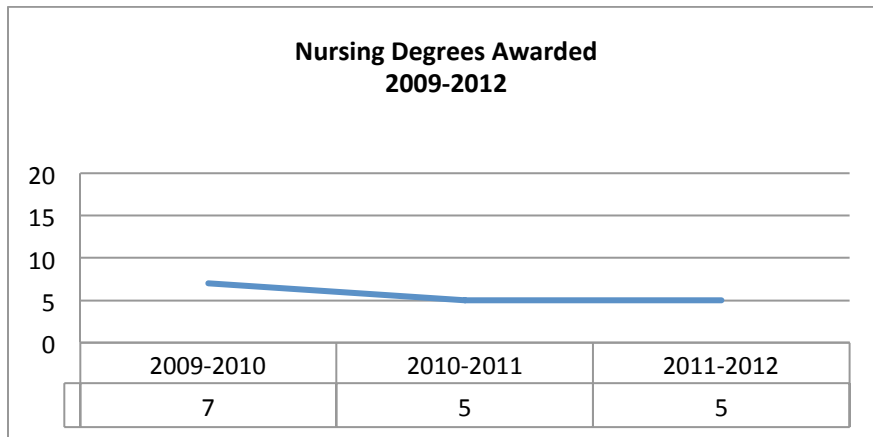


Environmental Geology Undergraduate Program

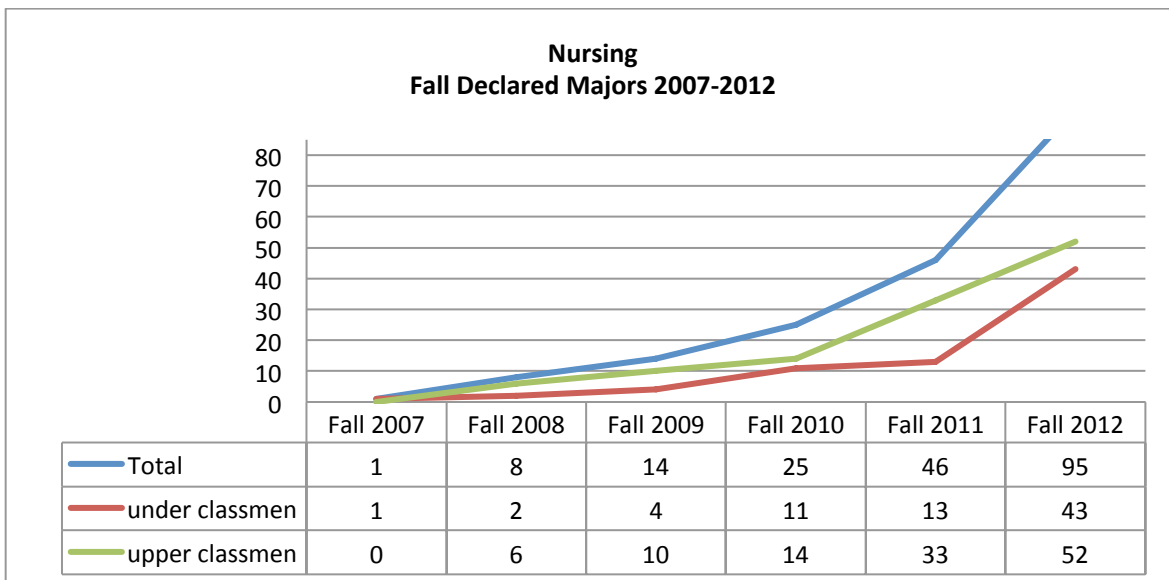

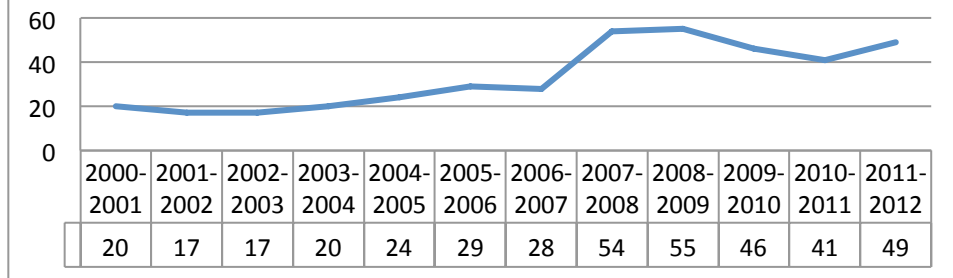


Fall Declared Business Student Enrollments 2000-2012

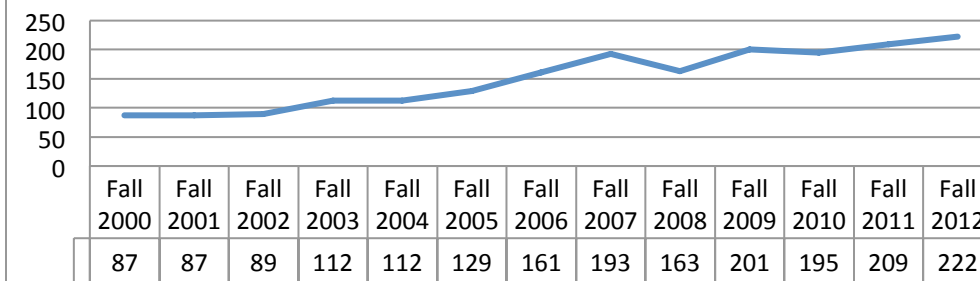

Master of Business Administration Degrees Awarded 2001-2012

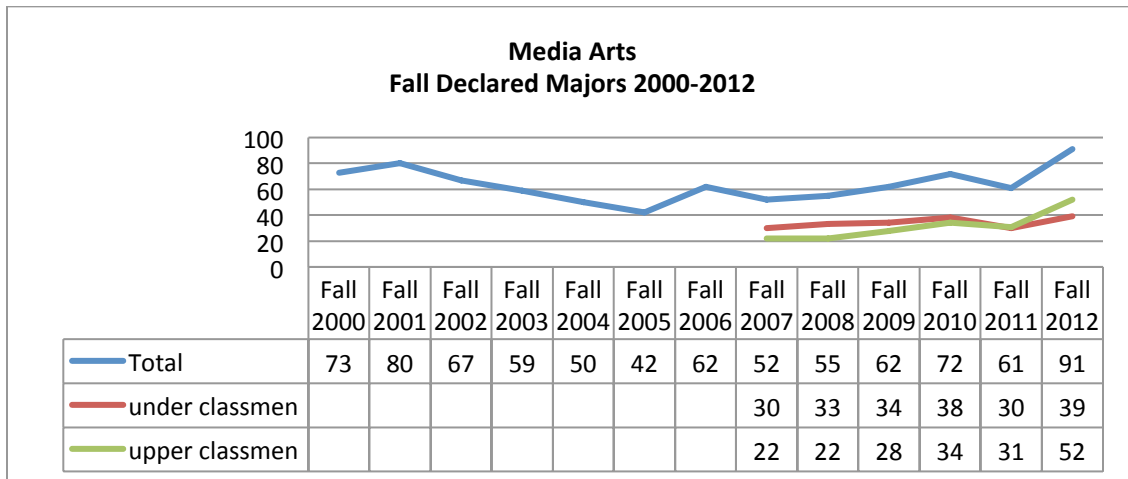
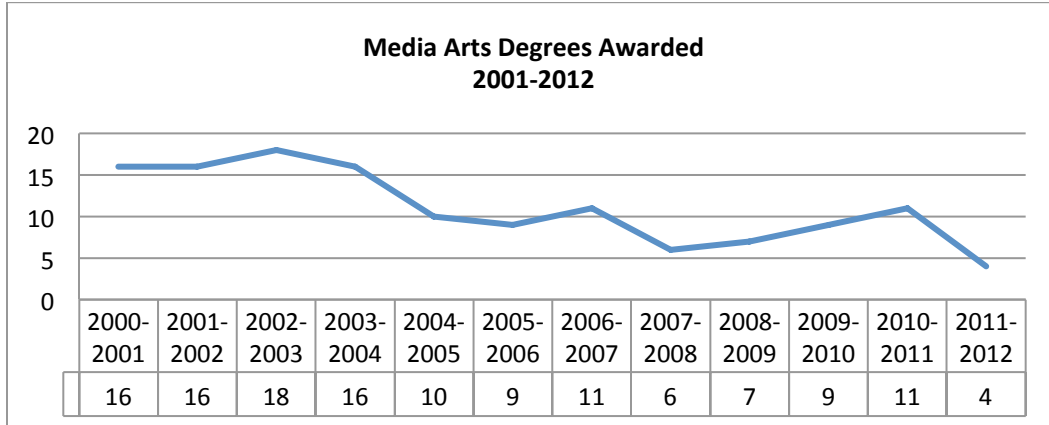


Master of Business Administration Fall Enrolled Students 2000-2012

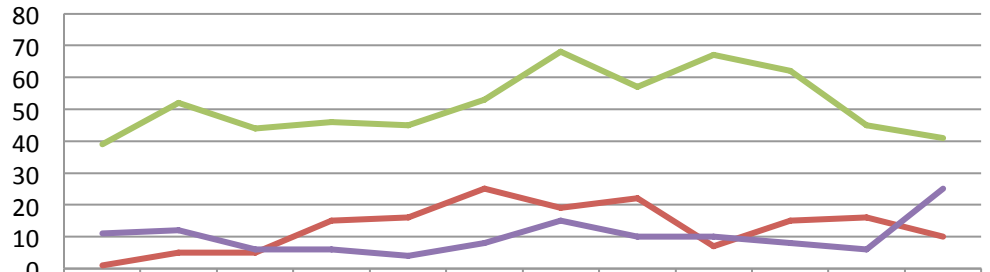

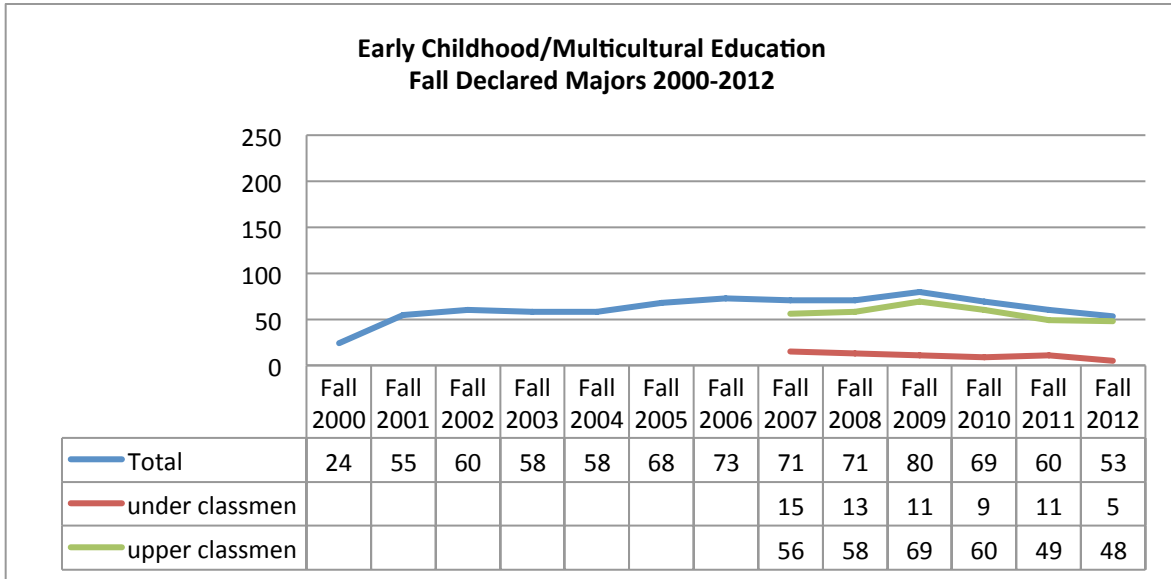

Education Degrees Awarded 2001-2012

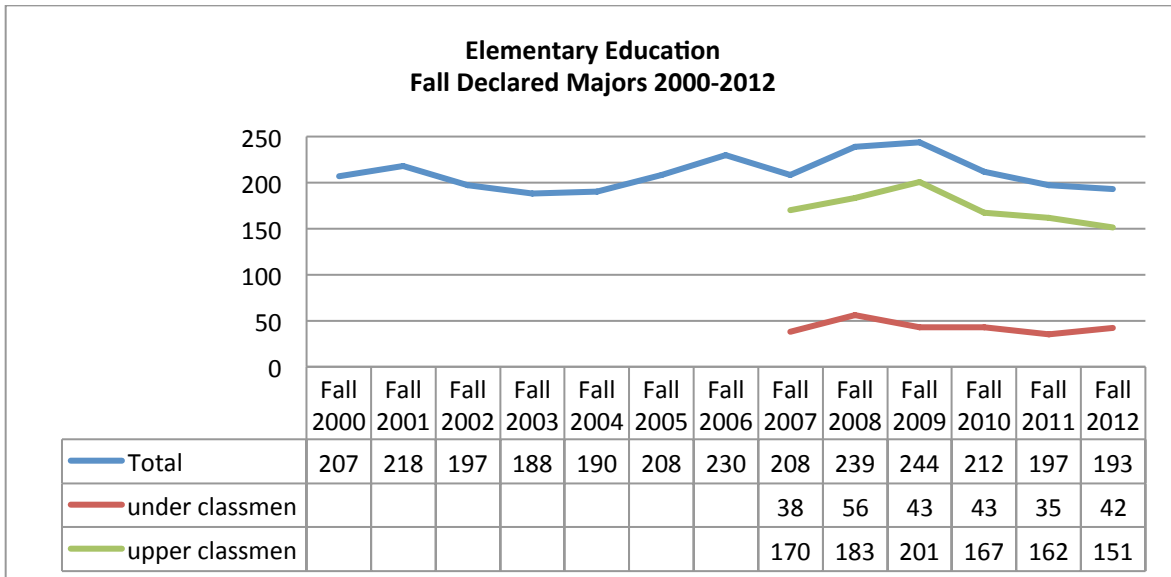
