This affects Article III, Executive Branch, Section 1-B, The President.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> YES</p> <p><input type="radio"/> NO</p> <p>Amendment 2 Amendment 2 reduces the number of semesters required for eligibility to serve as an executive officer from at least three (3) semesters as a Senator to at least two (2) semesters in ASNMHU. This affects Article VI, Election Procedures, Section 2. – Election of Officers.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> YES</p> <p><input type="radio"/> NO</p> <p>Amendment 3 Amendment 3 adds clarifying language which prescribes consequences (removal from office) and action for how officers are removed from office for not maintaining minimum eligibility requirements related to grade point average and disciplinary standing, which include a letter of notification signed by the Dean of Students (or designee) and Student Senate President, as well as requiring confirmation of the Senate. This affects Article I., Section 1-Definitions: F. Good Standing.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> YES</p> <p><input type="radio"/> NO</p> <p>Amendment 4 Amendment 4 adds clarifying language which prescribes consequences (removal from office) and action for how officers are removed from office for not maintaining minimum eligibility requirements related to grade point average and disciplinary standing, which include a letter of notification signed by the Dean of Students (or designee) and Student Senate President, as well as requiring confirmation of the Senate. This affects Article II – Legislative Branch, Section 4. – Qualifications of Senators.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> YES</p> <p><input type="radio"/> NO</p> <p>Amendment 5 Amendment 5 adds clarifying language related to removal from office procedures for not maintaining minimum eligibility requirements related to grade point average and disciplinary standing, which include a letter of notification signed by the Dean of Students (or designee) and Student Senate President, as well as requiring confirmation of the Senate. This affects Article IX, Resignation, Removal and Impeachment, Section 2. Removal.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> YES</p> <p><input type="radio"/> NO</p> <p>Amendment 6 Amendment 6 clarifies that terms of office for executives follows the academic calendar and also adds the term "appointed" since many officers are appointed to ASNMHU in addition to those who are elected. This affects Article I., Section 1-Definitions, P. Term of Office for Executives.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> YES</p> <p><input type="radio"/> NO</p>	<p>Amendment 7 Amendment 7 clarifies that terms of office for senators follows the academic calendar and also adds the term "appointed" since many officers are appointed to ASNMHU in addition to those who are elected. This affects Article I., Section 1 – Definitions, Q. Terms of Office for Senators.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> YES</p> <p><input type="radio"/> NO</p> <p>Amendment 8 Amendment 8 specifies that at least a 24-hour notice be given to Senators and Executives for an Emergency or Special Meeting. It also deletes the provision in the constitution that allows for a telephone vote/poll of confidence. This amendment affects Article II, Section 6-D, Emergency/Special Legislation.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> YES</p> <p><input type="radio"/> NO</p> <p>Amendment 9 Amendment 9 clarifies that Senators and Executive Officers enjoy speaking privileges during Senate meetings, proceedings, or deliberations. By specifically naming Executive Officers, speaking privileges are extended to the Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Attorney General, who have always enjoyed speaking privileges, but the current language does not specify as much. This affects Article II, Legislative Branch, Section 11. Debate.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> YES</p> <p><input type="radio"/> NO</p> <p>Amendment 10 Amendment 10 adds language under the Section pertaining to the Secretary. The language clarifies that the ASNMHU Secretary develops the meeting agendas with the approval of the executive officers. It also spells out that in the event of a vacancy in the Secretary position, all correspondence (such as letters of interest, resumes) should be addressed to the ASNMHU President. This affects Article III Executive Branch, Section 6. The Secretary.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> YES</p> <p><input type="radio"/> NO</p> <p>Amendment 11 Amendment 11 gives ASNMHU the discretion of requesting receipts and/or activity reports from individuals, clubs, or organizations that receive funding from Student Senate. This affects Article V. Finance, Section 3, Authority of Financial Control.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> YES</p> <p><input type="radio"/> NO</p> <p>Amendment 12 Amendment 12 adds language that clarifies the ways Executives might leave their positions and thereby forfeit any compensation upon leaving office, which may include resignation, removal, impeachment, or completion of term.
