Pre-Engineering/General Engineering Program

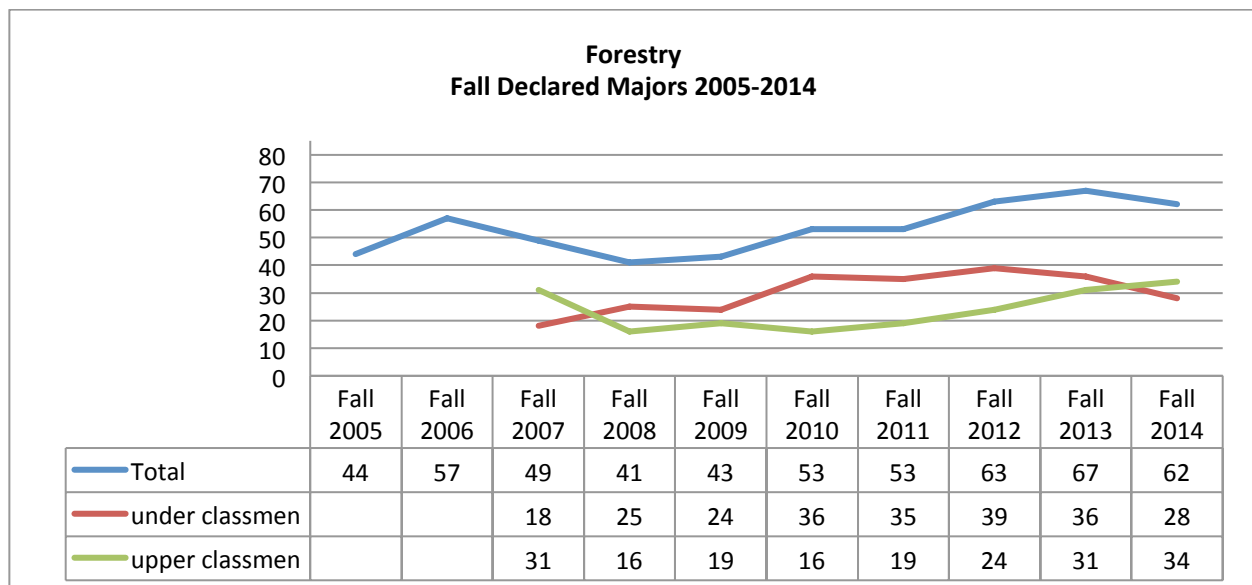
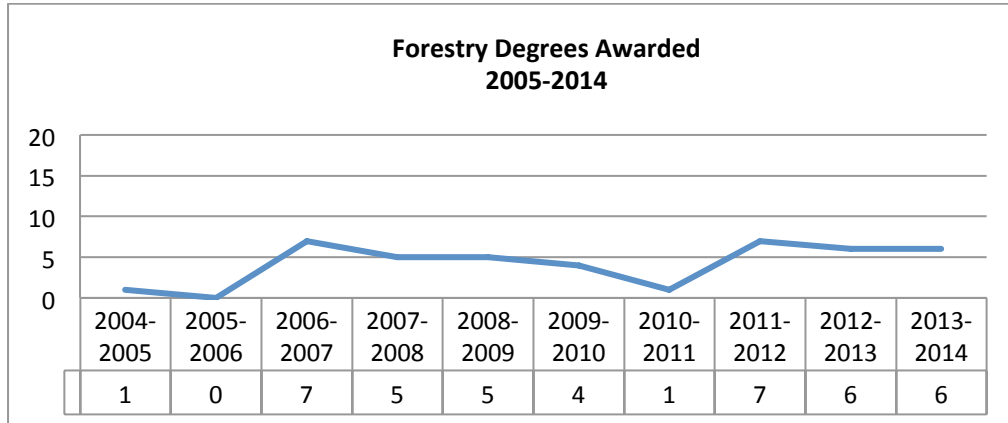

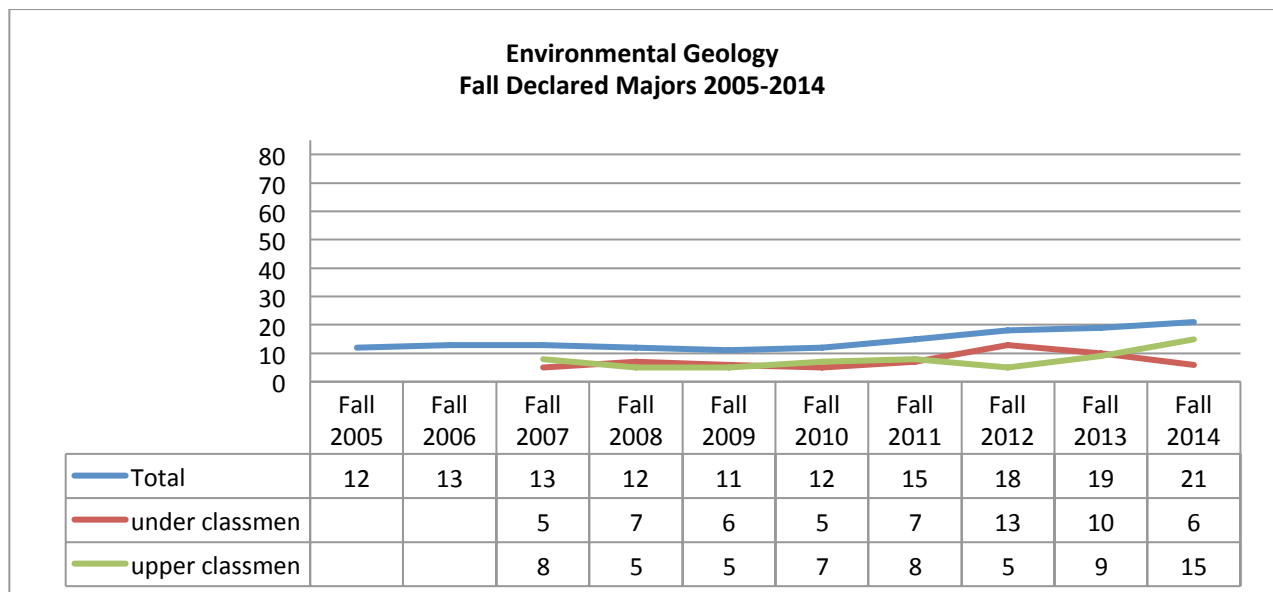
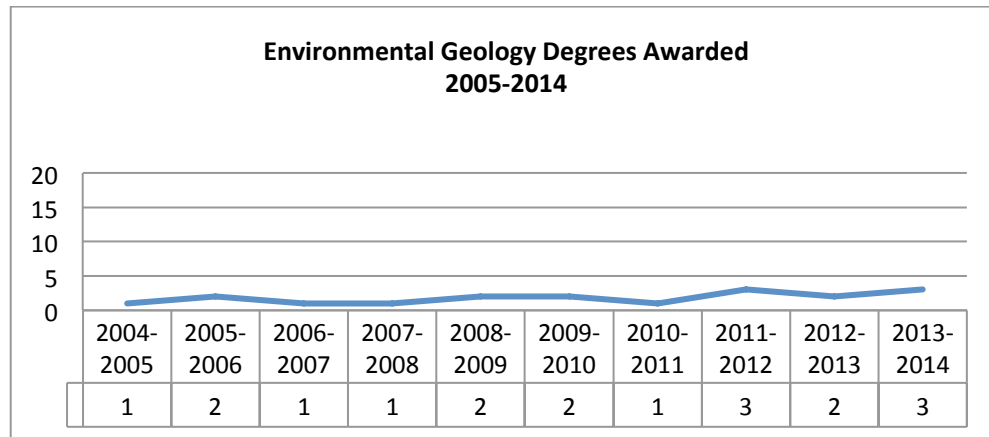
Forestry Undergraduate Program

These graphs include the majors from the Natural Resource Management program and Environmental Science majors with a concentration in environmental science. Both of those programs were subsumed into the current Forestry program.

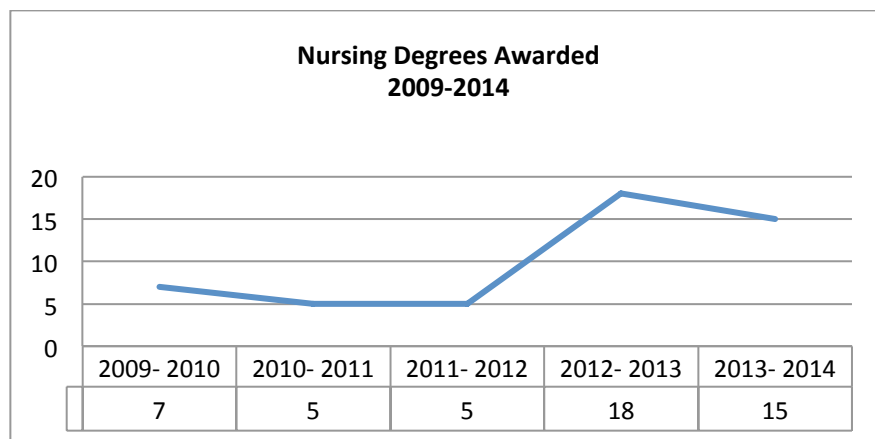

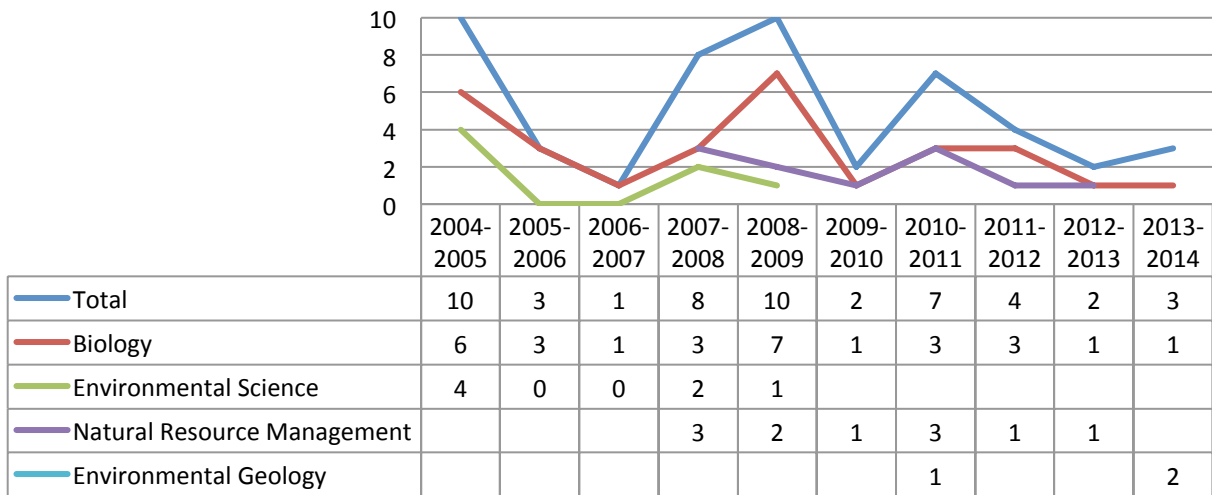


When viewing the chart below it should be noted that the fall of 2014 was the first semester in which undergraduate students were encouraged to declare university studies as a major.

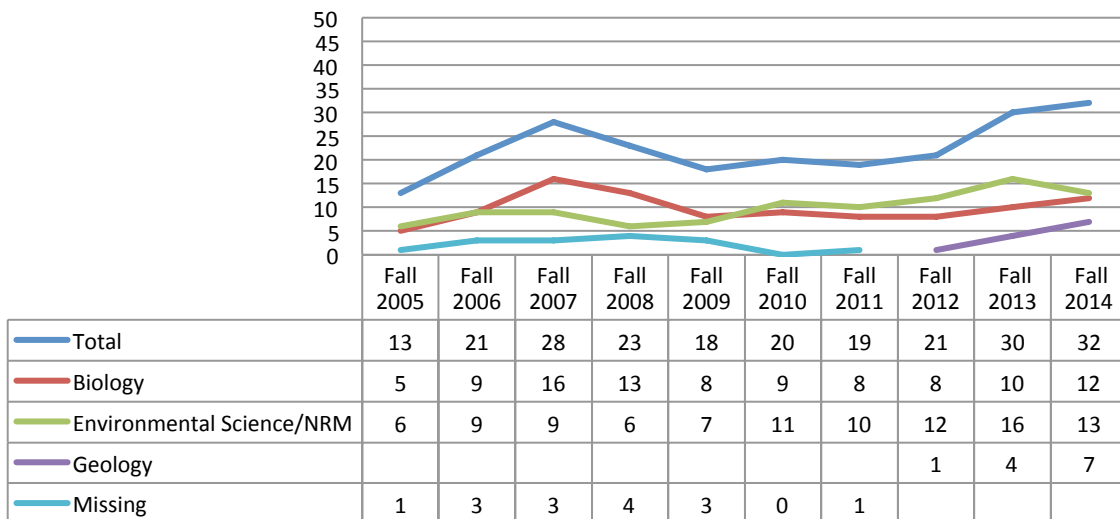

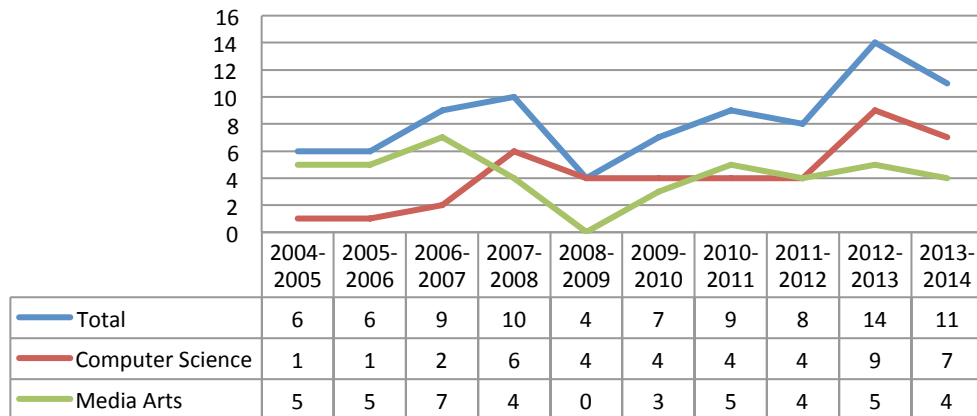

Fall Enrolled Students 2005-2014**

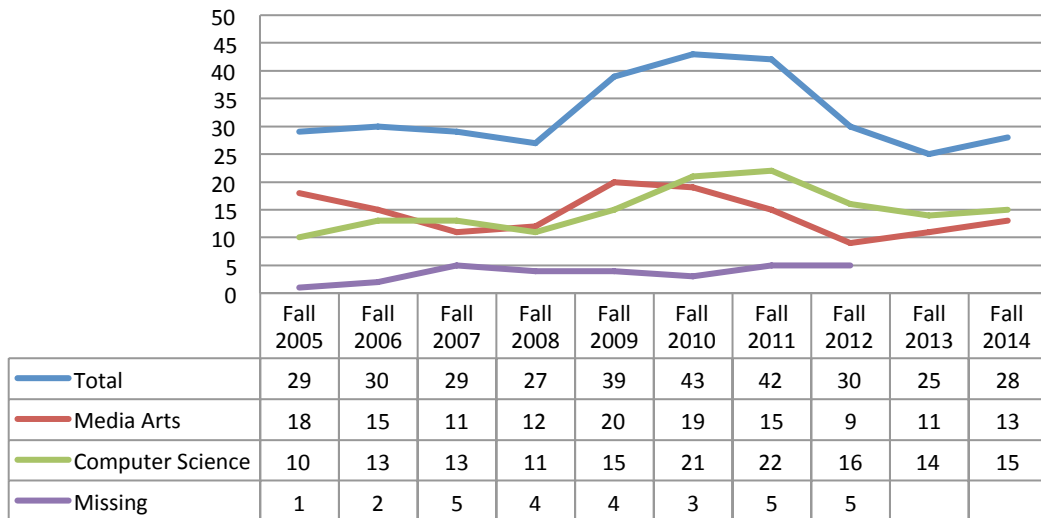

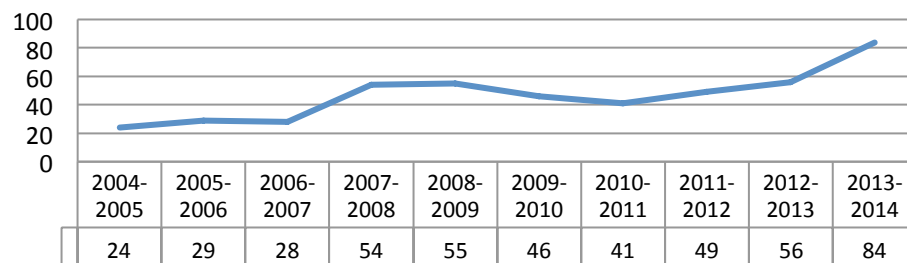


Fall Declared Business Student Enrollments 2005-2014

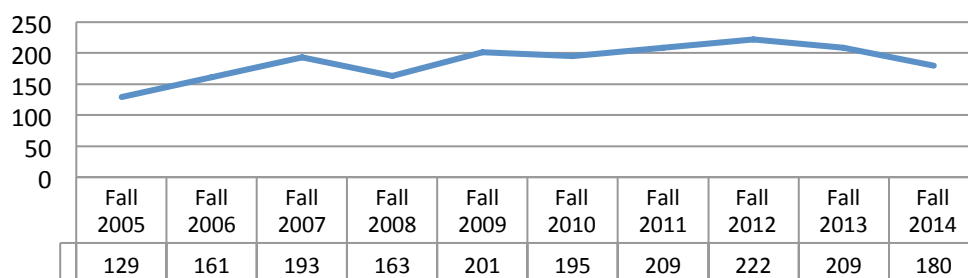

Master of Business Administration Degrees Awarded 2005-2014

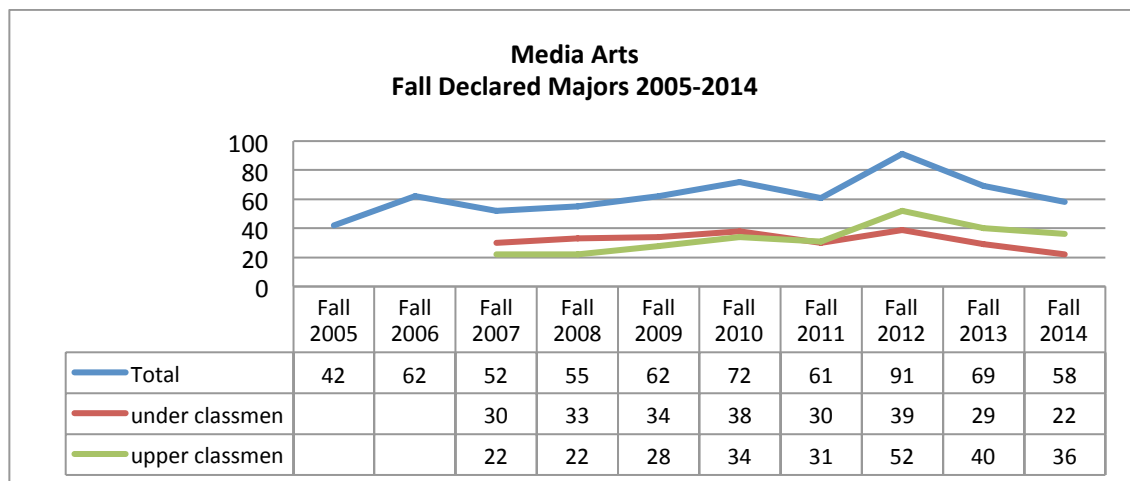
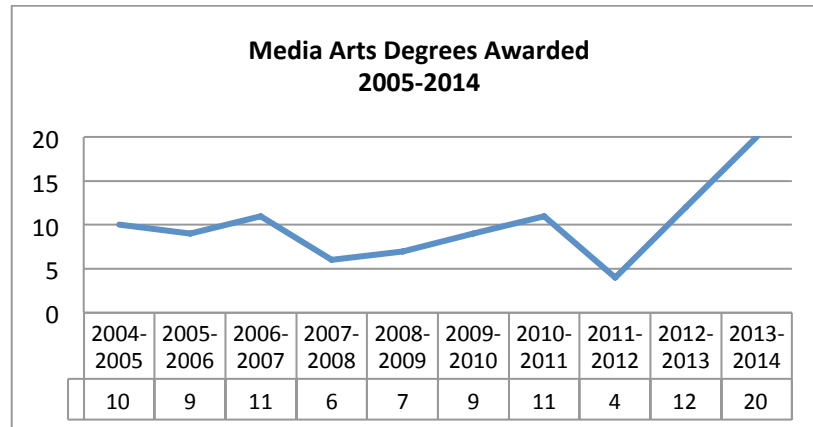


**Master of Business Administration
Fall Enrolled Students 2005-2014**



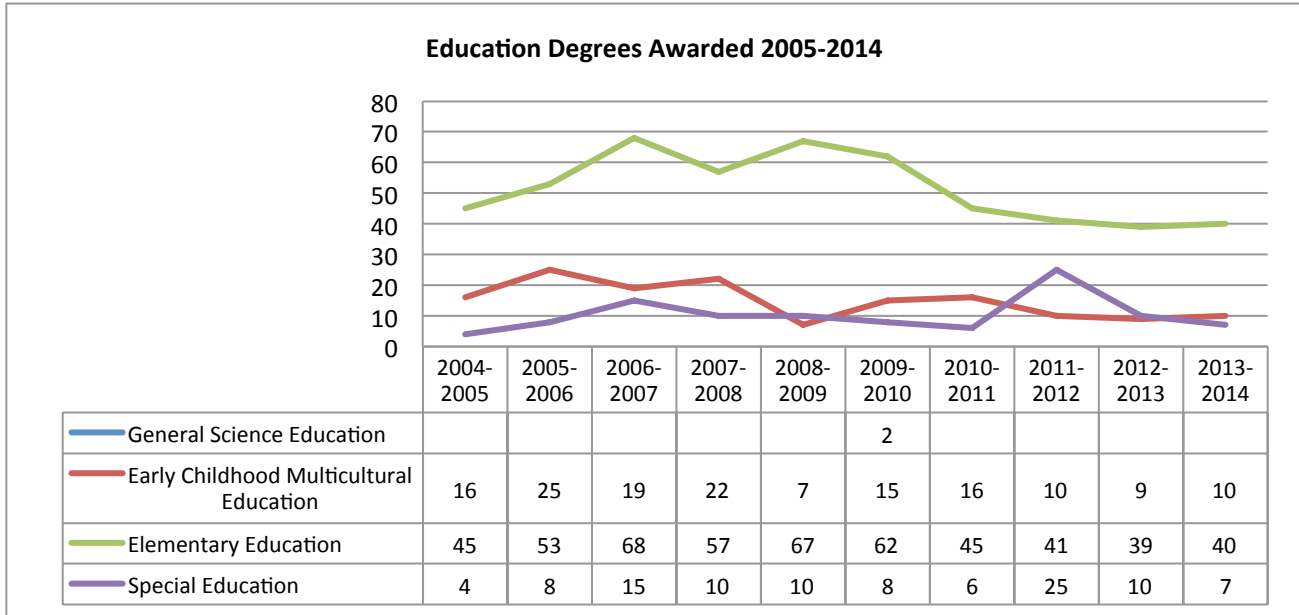
Media Arts Undergraduate Program

These charts include the discontinued majors of Design Studies, Communication Arts, Mass Communication and Visual Communication Design majors all of which were subsumed into the Media Arts major.

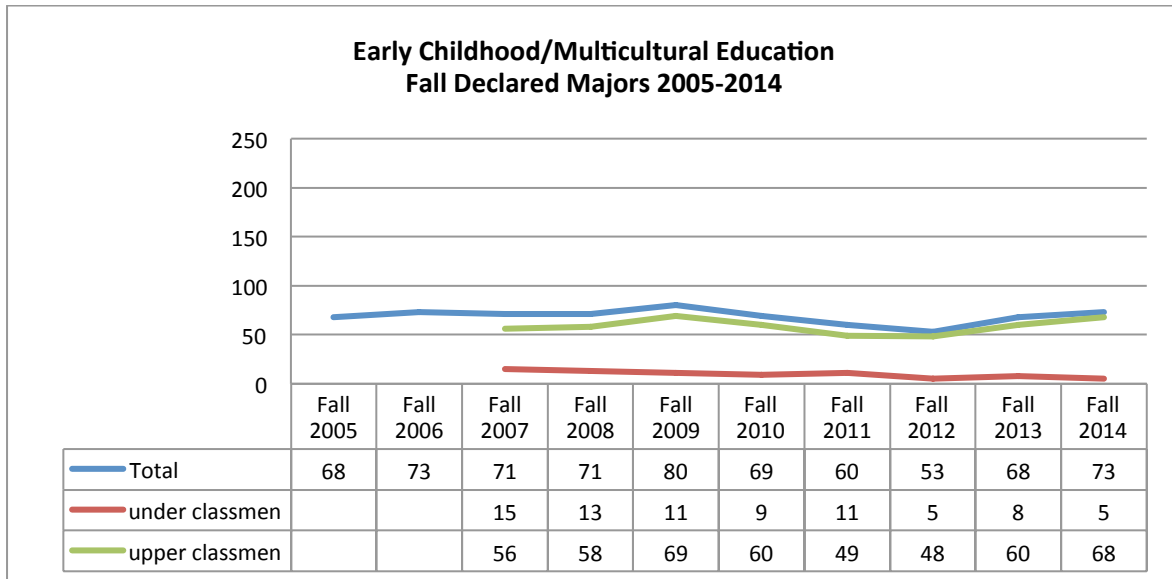
