- 1. Advising to graduation: every student every semester
- 2. Eliminate unnecessary barriers / requirements (on-line application payments option)
- 3. Review all our programs and how we schedule classes
- 4. Define the role of our Centers and their growth potential
- 5. Center for Teaching Excellence



Steps to Foster, support, facilitate, expect, and celebrate our value-added student success

- 6. Increase opportunities for student participation beyond the classroom
- 7. Establish tuition, fee and scholarship rates for 2015 by mid-October
- Analyze data to maximize yields and focus recruiting efforts: NE New Mexico, Transfers, International, Native American, Out-of-State, Centers, and Programs
- 9. Promote both parts of Affordable Excellence

- 10. Analyze our enrollment capacity by program, center, and funding
- 11. Increase number of new students for fall 2015 by at least 10%
