

Student Headcount and Credit Hours by Campus Where Classes Are Taken

A Report by the Office of Institutional Effectiveness and Research

February 2015

The numbers in the charts on the next two pages are based upon where students are taking courses in a given semester, not their static campus assignment in Banner. The credit hours are unduplicated, and the headcounts are unduplicated for each campus, but the headcounts are duplicated across campuses since students may be taking courses at more than one campus in any semester.

There were 3,351 students enrolled at Highlands on the day these data were pulled. Of those 794 are taking courses on two or more campuses. The most common combination is students who are taking courses face-to-face on the main campus and on the web.

A full third of our students (1,268) are taking at least one course via the web. Over 18% (618) are taking all of their courses this semester via the web. Only a minority of these students (19%) are full-time, degree-seeking.

Currently Highlands only has three degree programs that can be completed completely online, the graduate business program (MBA), the graduate program in Human Performance and Sports (HPS), and the undergraduate degree completion program in nursing (BSN). Business and Nursing account for the majority of our online courses.

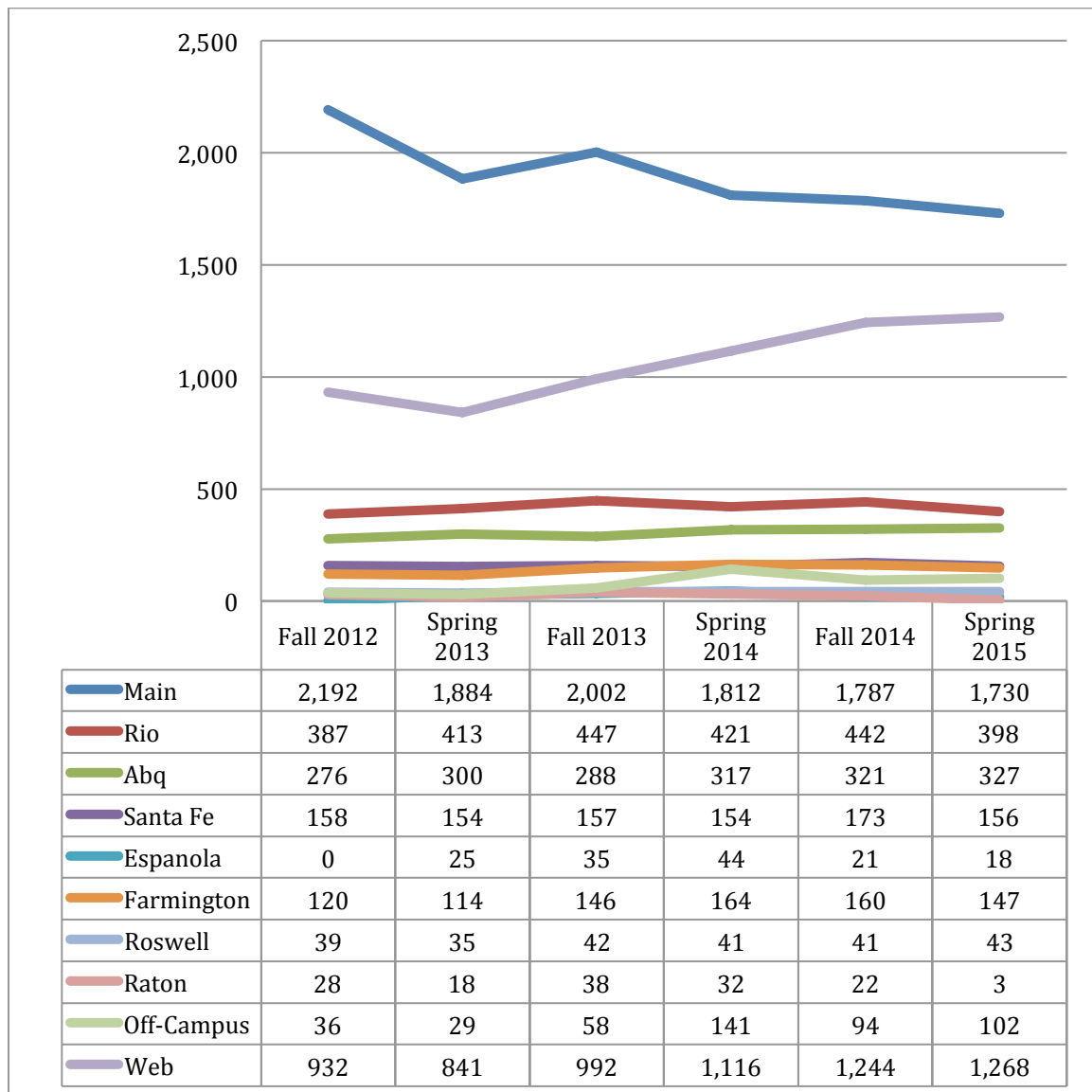

There are 30 students taking solely online courses who have out-of-state mailing addresses, however only 14 of these students are enrolled in programs which can be completed completely online (8 MBA, 3 BSN, and 3 graduate HPS). It should be remembered that the mailing address is not a completely accurate indicator of where a student is actually living. A student could conceivably have an out-of-state mailing address in Banner and still be physically living in New Mexico.

There are 325 students taking at least one course via ITV (they are not sitting in the same room as the instructor). However, only 66 of these students are taking all of their courses via ITV.
