Children in the Library Policy

Donnelly Library strives to provide an atmosphere conductive to study and research. Patrons with children are welcome; however, to protect your children, as well as in recognition of the rights and privileges of other library patrons, please observe the following:

Definition of children in this policy: children ages 13 and under.

- Children may not be left unattended in the library.
- Anyone bringing young children into the library shall take full and complete responsibility for them and must monitor their activity.
- Children are expected to use the library in a quiet, orderly manner just as we expect from all patrons. Loud, noisy or disruptive behavior is inappropriate in the library. Children, as well as the responsible adult, will be asked to leave if this type of behavior occurs.
- Anyone being disruptive will be asked to leave the library.
- NMHU campus police will be notified if disruptive behavior continues.

Children may not use computers or other equipment in the library unless under direct adult supervision. There are no filters on internet access.
