General Engineering Program

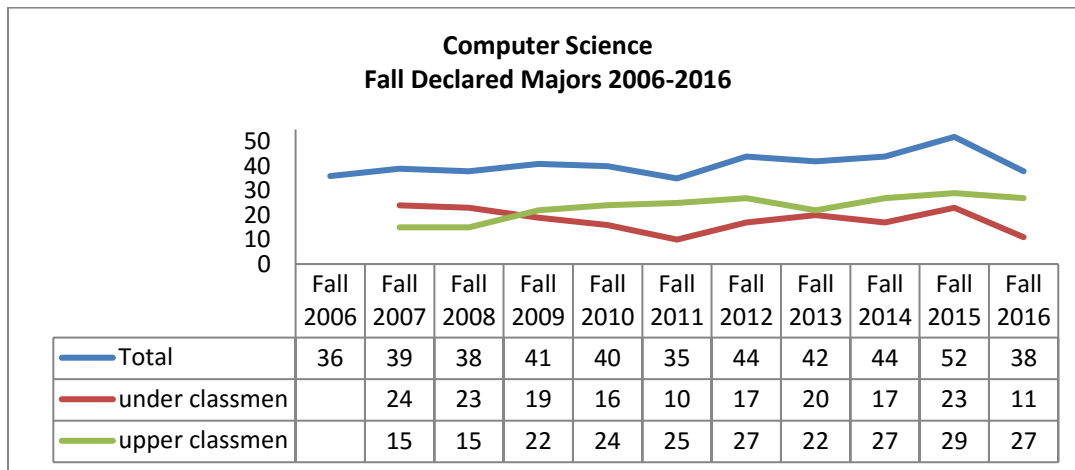

The graphs below are the Natural Resource Management program and Environmental Science majors with a concentration in environmental science. Both programs were subsumed into the current Forestry program.

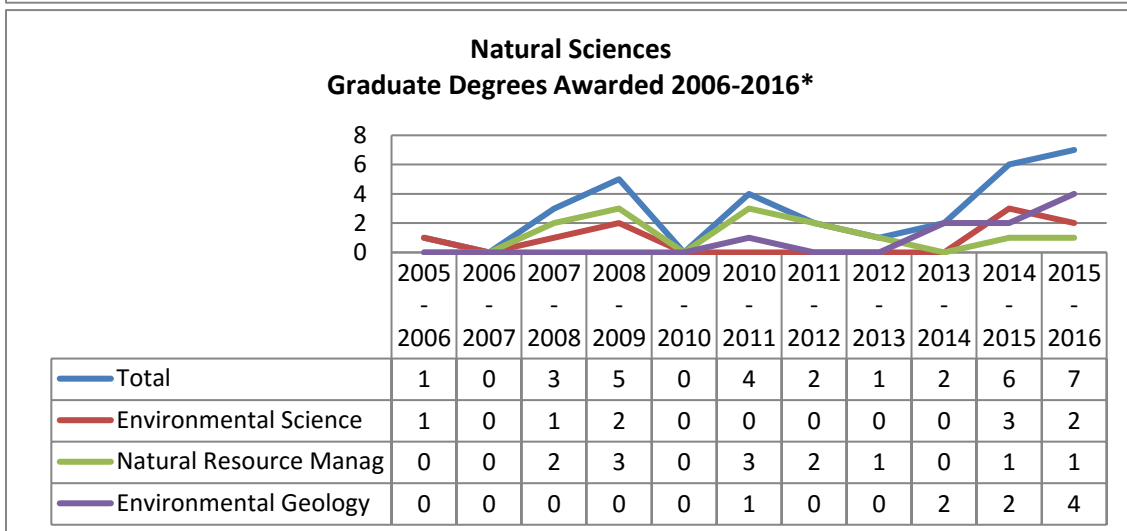
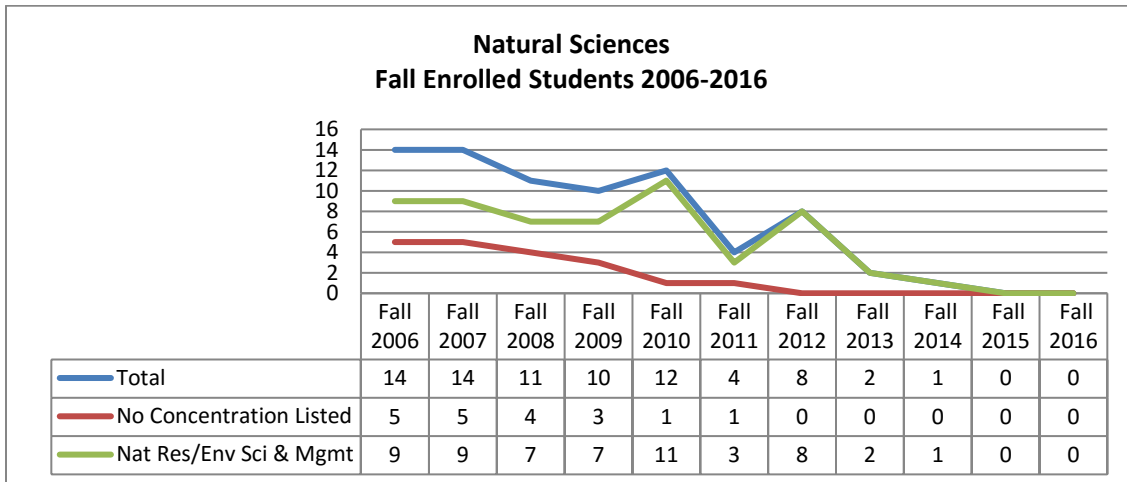

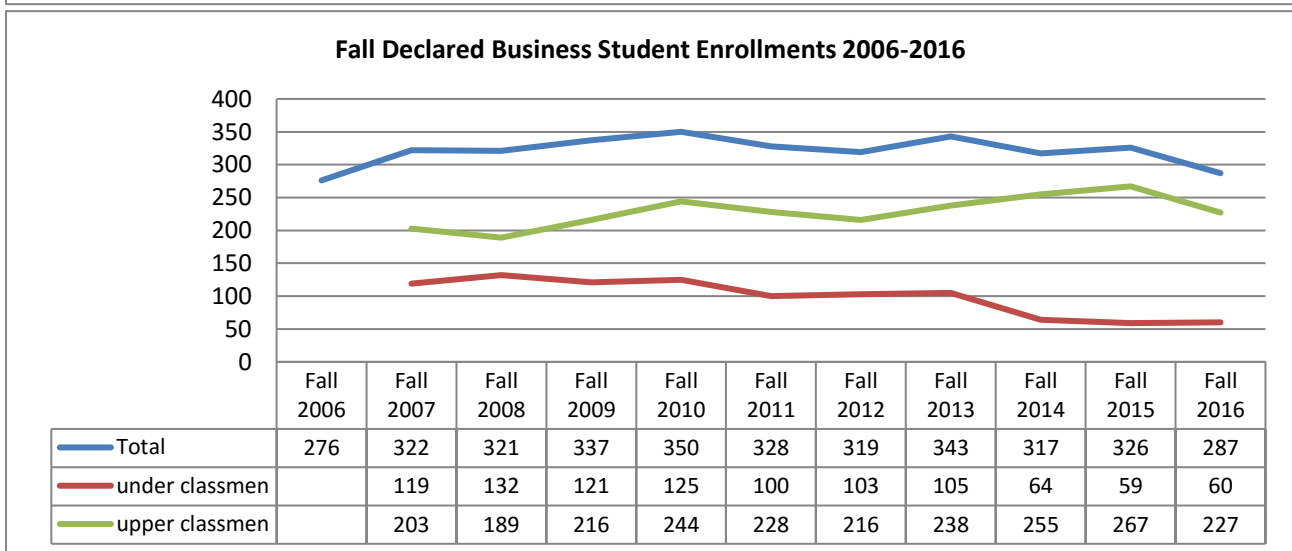
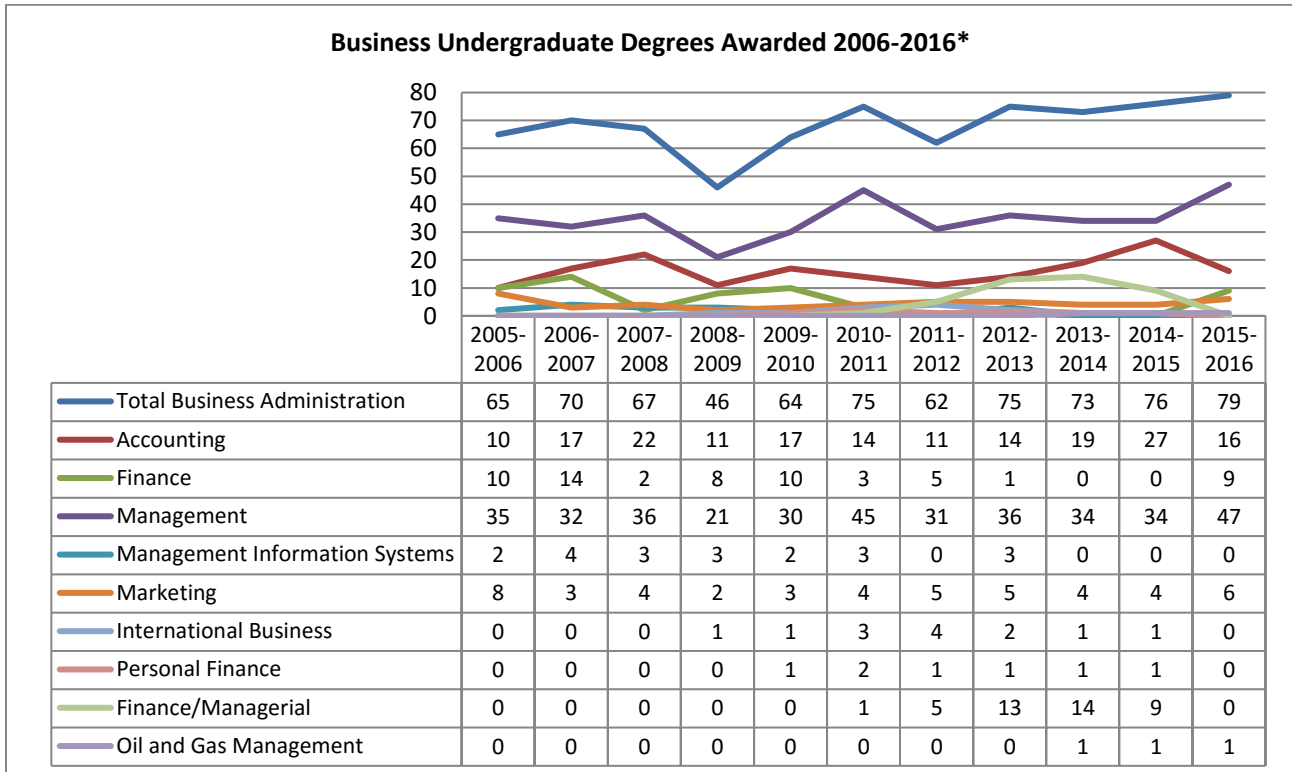
When viewing the chart below it should be noted that the fall of 2014 was the first semester in which undeclared undergraduate students were encouraged to declare university studies as a major.

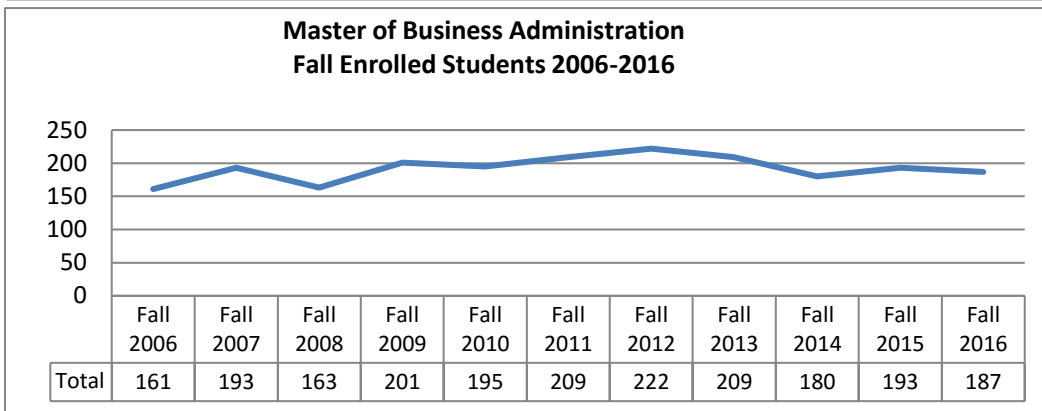
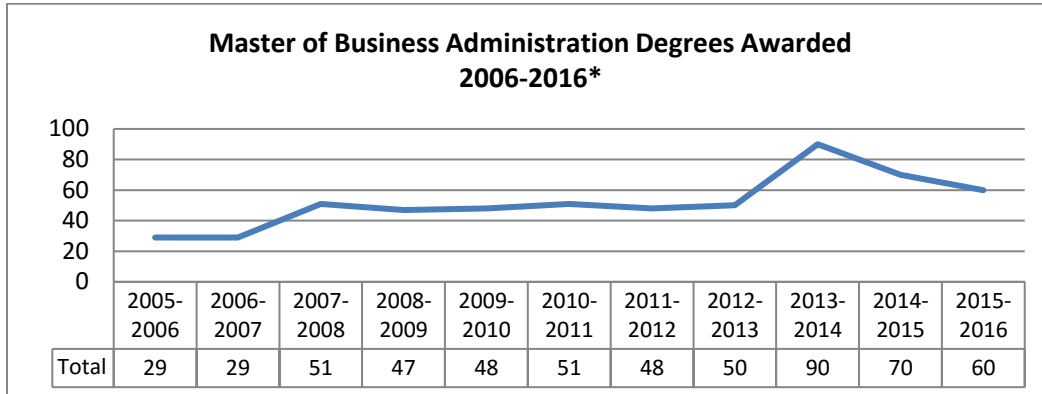
Business Undergraduate Program
