Citation Management Software

What is Citation Management Software?

- It's also called reference management software and personal bibliographic management software
- Automatically imports bibliographic information
- Tracks and organizes bibliographic citations
- Creates the citation
- Creates the works cited page or bibliography page
- Collaborate and share with others
- Some allow you to save the information resource itself
- Some allow you to make notes

Major Citation Management Software Programs

EndNote

- EndNote Basic Free
 - Web based, limited to 50,000 citations
- EndNote X8- \$250 (student pricing available)
 - PC based
 - Allows you to share with other researchers
- EndNote for iPad \$100 add-on
 - Sync across iPad, desktop and online

Mendeley

- 2 GB of storage for free
- Store documents on PC
- Store citation information on Mendeley's server
- PDF viewer with sticky notes and text highlighting
- Mobile apps
- Share with colleagues

RefWorks

- \$100 per year
- References stored online
- Can export directly from some of the library's databases
- Creates in-text citations
- RefShare to share with others
- Product support

Zotero

- Free
- PC based
- Icon on sources allows you to download citation automatically
- Save copy of article
- Organized via drag and drop
- Write notes
- Sync with mobile devices
- No support, but extensive help on website
