Students completing the Associate of Arts in General Psychology at Northern New Mexico College can apply those credits and courses directly toward the Bachelor of Social Work at New Mexico Highlands University.

Students that earn the A.A. in General Psychology at NNMC are granted additional transfer benefits to NMHU. NMHU will waive: Physical Education (2crhrs) requirements. English Literature (3crhrs) and Language other than English (8crhrs) requirements. In addition, upon completion of the Junior Year in the BSW degree program at NMHU, Students will receive the opportunity to apply to the graduate/Masters of Social Work Advanced Standing Program.

The NMHU Bachelor of Social Work Program coursework begins each Fall; thus, students are primarily admitted for Fall semester (with exception). For more information on NMHU's Admission and Application practice, please contact NMHU School of Social Work. NMHU School of Social Work requires that all transfer coursework must be completed with a "C" of higher. Students under this agreement are waived of the final 15 credits of residency established by NMHU.

This agreement will be reviewed periodically by both parties and will be subject to changes upon agreement by both parties. The agreement can be rescinded at the discretion of either party with ninety days' notice.
