



**Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) Application
New Mexico Highlands University
Las Vegas, NM 87701**

The Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) is a program through which Undergraduate students in nineteen participating states and territories may enroll in designated two-year and four-year institutions, as well as programs in other participating states at a special, reduced tuition level application only to WUE students at a rate of a hundred and fifty percent of in-state tuition. In all programs, the sum is substantially less than non-resident tuition. To receive the WUE tuition benefits, students do not need to demonstrate financial need.

States and territories participating in WUE are Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, North Dakota, Oregon, South Dakota, Utah, Washington, Wyoming, the Commonwealth of Northern Mariana Islands, Federated States of Micronesia, Guam, the Republic of Marshall Islands, and American Samoa. WUE is coordinated by the Western Interstate Commissions for Higher Education (WICHE) a regional agency created by western states in the early 1950's.

Application:

Students who wish to participate in the WUE program must complete the application on the reverse side of this form. Return your completed application to the Office of the Registrar.

Tuition:

WUE students must meet regular requirements for admissions to the participating university and must be a resident of one of the following states or territories: Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, North Dakota, Oregon, South Dakota, Utah, Washington, Wyoming, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, Federated States of Micronesia, Guam, the Republic of Marshall Islands, and American Samoa.

Renewal:

The student must be in good academic and disciplinary standing and must complete the waiver application each semester for renewal. Academic and/or disciplinary probation disqualifies the student. WUE programs are open to students on a per space available basis: All NMHU Undergraduate programs are open to WUE students. This form must be processed prior to the census date of the semester in which you are applying and the student must be admitted under degree seeking status.
