AN ACT

Providing Input on the University Vision and Strategic Plan

WHEREAS, New Mexico Highlands University is in the midst of developing a five year strategic plan, "NM Highlands University Vision 2020"; and

WHEREAS, a Steering Committee comprised of various constituencies from across campus have been compiling information and coordinating/facilitating discussions and emergent themes as priorities for the strategic plan; and

WHEREAS, ASNMHU has been approached by Provost Aguilar, Chair of the Strategic Planning Steering Committee, to provide additional input and feedback representing the students perspective on these important matters related to university core values, guiding principles, and proposed priorities; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the 2015-2016 Associated Students of New Mexico Highlands University, endorses the proposed core values and mission statement as presented, as well as the inclusion of language in Section A. Academic Excellence, Academic Integration, & Student Success to reflect a commitment on the part of the university toward and investment in resources supporting a more vibrant campus life through social/cultural enrichment activities as well as physical and recreational opportunities.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the 2015-16 Associated Students of New Mexico Highlands University also endorses language supporting an emphasis on a quality and safe educational environment, with particular focus on campus safety and security pertaining to facilities, lighting, and enhanced campus security.
