**Interpretation of Results for Outcome 1:** All of the students have demonstrated “Mastery of Content Knowledge and Skills” as documented in the classroom observation and evaluation by the University Supervisor (100%). The Cooperating Teacher has indicated that the student teachers have mastered appropriate curriculum to the instruction that is appropriate to children’s developmental level, interest, cultural values, home experiences and language (100%). The early childhood curriculum is meeting the requirements for preparing student teachers for the classroom.

**Interpretation of Results for Outcome 2:** Students have demonstrated “Effective Communication Skills” documented by the outcomes of the final evaluation by the University Supervisor and the final assessment by the Cooperating Teacher. Eight out of nine students met criteria for “The teacher communicates with and obtains feedback in a manner that enhances student learning and understanding.” All of the students met the criteria for “seeking and maintaining a collaborative relations with parents, guardians, families, community agencies, and other professionals to meet the needs of each child” (100%). This data indicated that student teachers are well prepared to communicate with students, parents, and fellow professionals.
