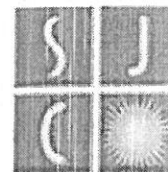


Memorandum of Understanding

The Guaranteed Transfer Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between New Mexico Highlands University (NMHU) and San Juan College (SJC) allows transfer students from SJC to continue their studies at NMHU with a seamless, efficient, and clearly defined pathway to Bachelor's degree completion.

The SJC courses listed below offer the content necessary to satisfy the corresponding NMHU courses and are approved for direct NMHU substitution. The substitution is limited to the actual credit hours completed.

1. Substitution only approved for completion of SJC PSYC 210 during or after Fall 2017 semester.
2. Students who have an earned Associate's Degree will have NMHU proficiency, extended core, and minor requirements waived.
3. This course substitution memorandum will remain in effect until superseded by a new catalog, catalog revisions, new articulation agreement, or superseded by another course substitution memorandum.
4. The NMHU undergraduate Psychology major requires a minimum of 45 credit hours of major courses with a grade point average of 2.0 or higher.
5. Substituted courses must have a grade of "C" or higher.
6. At least 18 of the major course credit hours must be at the upper-division level (numbered 300-499).
7. At least 18 of the major course credit hours must be completed at NMHU.
