- Discussion of ongoing enrollment concerns
- Need to reach out to non-traditional students while continuing to strengthen Las Vegas enrollment
- Question raised as to whether our probation status is still impacting enrollment – probably not, looks like the fall 2016 cohort was affected most strongly
- Discussion of overall focus of Criterion 4C: emphasis is on developing an effective and sustainable model of strategic enrollment management
 - However, part of Criterion 5A does focus on stabilization or growth in enrollment, so the HLC does want to see measurable results of our efforts
- We are still working to get the SEM Plan approved in Faculty Senate
- Evidence document for HLC will be presented to Faculty and Staff Senate, as well as to BOR and EMT, but does not require formal approval
- Initial Recommendations for 4C section of evidence document:
 - Mention Matriculation Task Force, which worked on streamlining our processes and procedures and well as recommending some policy revisions; Task Force also recommended implementing new technologies including Slate and TouchNet
 - Mention hiring of Director of Online Learning
 - Refer to specific recruitment and retention initiatives mentioned in unit strategic plans
