- I am currently in the U.S. Armed Forces and on active duty this exception does not apply to members of Reserve and National Guard who are not on active duty. (Please provide a copy of one of the following: Leave and Earning Statement, Military Orders, Military Personal Record, or Letter from Commanding Officers)
- I am registered with Selective Service. Attach documentation of your registration status.

- I am a citizen of the Republic of Palau, the Republic of the Marshall Islands, or the Federated States of Micronesia. However, a citizen or national of the Republic of the Marshall Islands or the Federated States of Micronesia who lives in the United States for more than one year for any reason except as a student or employee of the government of his homeland must register. (Please provide a copy of your passport.)
- I was a non-citizen who first entered the U.S. after I turned 26. (Please provide a copy of your stamped I-94 or U.S. Visa)
- I was a non-citizen who entered the U.S. as a lawful non-immigrant on a valid visa and remained in the U.S. on the terms of that visa until after I turned 26. (Please provide a copy of your stamped I-94 or U.S. Visa)
- I was unable to register due to hospitalization, incarceration or institutionalization. (Please provide a typed brief explanation on a separate sheet and submit it with this verification form.)
- I was enrolled in an officer procurement program at The Citadel, North Georgia College and State University, Norwich University, Virginia Military Institute, Texas A&M University, or Virginia Polytechnic and State University. (Please provide documentation of your entire enrollment.)
- I am a commissioned Public Health Service officer on active duty or a member of the Reserve of the Public Health Service on specified active duty.
- I **am not registered**, but I have received a Status Letter from Selective Service **stating that I was not required to register**. Attach a copy of your status letter.
